Dunclutha Children’s Home although within Argyll and Bute was run by the Glasgow Corporation prior to 1976 and records will be held by Glasgow City Council as the successor authority. Social work records are normally held by the placing authority and as you advised that Ms Mullen was resident in the Clydebank area prior to being taken into care I would recommend a subject access request is made to West Dunbartonshire Council for records.
