Trevor's nocturnal visit. They found it hard to believe he'd gotten out - probably used his sister's key. Both clearly exasperated and feeling they have nothing left to offer Trevor. Long discussion about problems - Mrs. Norman expressed her concern that Trevor has a large knife, two coats, and a chain in his room. Feels situation is deteriorating. Explained that while Ladyacre doesn't exist as a punishment, it is not a holiday camp. Mrs Trueman said that she wanted Trevor out of the house by Friday 4pm. On the journey to Ladyacre I told Trevor what his mother had said and Trevor said that if he could he would like to come to Ladyacre to live for a while. Trevor played at Ladyacre with residents and staff for two hours. I returned Trevor home and collected the letter from Mrs Trueman (she was just going to work). I said to Trevor and his mother that Ladyacre would contact the Social Work Department in the morning and that we would contact the family by lunchtime. On returning to Ladyacre a member of staff told me that Trevor had been talking about his relationship with his step-father. Trevor had said that his step-father had hit him but not for the last few weeks. Taking into consideration the fact that Trevor's mum was working all night and that Trevor was staying at the house with his step-father I contacted Danny McKeever to discuss the situation. It was decided that no further action would be taken this evening.



Trevor spoke to me last night about how he feels that he is increasingly becoming more short tempered / irritable / angry. He went on to explain that sometimes he feels like strangling or hitting out at staff. I asked Trevor to give me examples and to talk through the different stages. His first example was about a female resident who was annoying him and he felt like strangling her. He said that he worked it out in his mind and this helped him to stop him putting it into action. On several other occasions he said when he gets angry he has to carry out all the actions in his mind which, feels that he is actually carrying out this strangulation (it feels very real to him). He also spoke about how sometimes he wants to just pick something up and kill someone with the object. He also spoke about how he could be the complete opposite and have feelings that are totally different. i.e. He passed a van one day whilst walking and the keys were in the ignition. He felt for a split second that he would jump in and take ~~off~~ in the van. Then he said he felt sorry for the van owner and removed the keys and handed them in to the ~~building~~ where the guy was. I relayed to Trevor that he must discuss this with Rebecca Sawtell
