Following his last Hearing, Trevor managed to sustain his stay at Ladyacre for a period of only two weeks.

On 17th April 1995, Trevor was returned to Hightrees following a number of incidents at Ladyacre. These included sneaking a young girl into his bedroom during the night, staying out until the early hours of the morning and returning to the unit while under the influence of some substance(s). Upon his return to Hightrees, Trevor was extremely unco-operative and demanding. He continually disregarded all rules and was arrogant and challenging in his dealings with others. Packages of independent living skills and work experience were formulated by staff, but these were rejected by Trevor.

Throughout his time in care, Trevor has remained consistent in his desire to live with his uncle in Northumbria. Until recently, this has been difficult to facilitate due to family circumstances. These circumstances, however, have recently changed and after a Child in Care Review arrangements were made for Trevor to go on extended leave to live with his uncle. It was envisaged that Trevor would attempt to look for a work placement to start when he leaves school.

Reports from both Trevor and his uncle suggest that the placement is going well.

Trevor arrived unexpectedly in Dumfries on 14th May 1995. He presented himself, late in the evening, at Ladyacre and was returned to Hightrees for two nights. Trevor apparently had wished to visit his friends. Trevor, by his actions, has made it clear that he sees his future in Northumbria and Panel members may see it as appropriate to facilitate his permanent move there.

Trevor has been in the care of the Social Work Department since 22nd April 1994. This followed a demand from his mother that we accommodate Trevor because he was out of her control. Specifically he was refusing to communicate with his family, leaving the house at any time of the day or night through his bedroom window, not accepting certain house rules, playing his music loudly and smoking hash. Trevor had also been excluded permanently from comprehensive school.

Underlying reasons for this behaviour, it has been assumed, have been his mother's separation from his father when Trevor was 5 and the lack of any positive relationship between Trevor and his step-father.

Trevor also perceived his sisters as being treated more fairly at home than he was. All these factors have psychologically affected Trevor. His particular way of expressing his feelings of rejection has been through anger and an inclination not to trust most adults in positions of authority.

Trevor was admitted to Ladyacre in April 1994. He was expelled from the new school that he was enrolled into after a month for assaulting another pupil.

By and large, Trevor settled at Ladyacre for some months despite many tensions between him and members of staff. Trevor would also intimidate other residents. Karen, Trevor's mum, visited him at Ladyacre once a fortnight.

However, the situation deteriorated over the summer and autumn of 1994 with Trevor becoming increasingly difficult to control in any way, and Trevor not communicating with staff.

Trevor was transferred to Hightrees in November 1994, but continued to disregard all boundaries. Referrals had been made to Liz McIntyre, Educational Psychologist, but Trevor would not engage with her. Trevor was admitted to secure accommodation three weeks before Christmas 1994. A referral was made to John Powell, Child Psychiatrist, but again Trevor would not engage with him.

In January, Trevor left the secure unit to come back into Hightrees main unit. From this time, on the whole Trevor interacted more positively with staff and residents. At Ladyacre Trevor had made a positive bond with Jen Graham, a member of staff. Jen continued to see Trevor while he was at Hightrees and in secure, and Jen really became the only person that Trevor could talk to about his emotions, feelings, desires and wishes.

At Trevor's request, he moved back to Ladyacre in February 1995 under the provision that should his behaviour deteriorate, he would have to come back to Hightrees.

In April, Trevor's uncle from Newcastle contacted me to say that he and his wife would like Trevor to live with them as soon as possible. Just after this, unfortunately Trevor had to come back to Hightrees because staff again felt that Trevor was becoming uncontrollable, threatening staff and damaging property.

A Child in Care Review on 19th April 1995 agreed that Trevor could live with his uncle and aunt in Newcastle. A date was set for me to visit with Trevor prior to agreeing that Trevor could go permanently. However, Trevor left Hightrees for a weekend visit to his uncle and aunt and refused to return. I visited Trevor and Mrs Lang on 27th April 1995.

Trevor appeared to be most relaxed amongst his relatives, who themselves seemed to be delighted that Trevor was with them. The flat was not large and Trevor was sharing a room with his aunt's brother who is a few years older than Trevor. These two seemed to be getting on well. Trevor had helped in the Taxi firm headquarters where works, and told me that he found Trevor to have a great sense of humour and very helpful. was also positive about Trevor. It was agreed that Trevor would need to pursue YTS and job options after a short settling in period. The Social Work Department have agreed to fund £50.00 a week for one month.

In mid-May, Trevor came back to Dumfries for a weekend to visit friends. He went to Ladyacre and demanded that he be given a bed for the night because he was still technically on a Section 44(1)(b) to Hightrees. Hightrees put him up for the weekend.

At this point I tried to impress upon Trevor that he needs to plan such trips and communicate his plans to staff at Hightrees. Trevor went back to his uncle and aunt after the weekend.

Trevor has recently contacted Jen Graham at Ladyacre to say that he does not like Newcastle as much as he thought he would and wishes to come back to Dumfries. Trevor has stated that he wants to be placed at Nithsdale House, which is a popular boarding house with young people in Dumfries.

CONCLUSION

Since Trevor has been in the care of the Local Authority, I do not feel that Trevor has made any effort to co-operate with the residential units that he has been placed at. Trevor has not wanted to stay with foster carers and so the Department has accommodated Trevor at Ladyacre and Hightrees. Trevor has never really communicated with me about what he needs for the future.

Trevor moved to Newcastle following his uncle's invitation to come and stay with him and his wife. It now appears that Trevor wishes to come back to Dumfries.

RECOMMENDATION

That Trevor is made subject to a Section 44(1)(a) in order that the Social Work Department can help to settle Trevor back in Dumfries. It would be envisaged that once this has occurred, the Social work Department would wish to seek a Review for Trevor after approximately 3 months.

Background

Trevor was received into residential care aged 14 in February 1994. He was discharged from a supervision requirement in July 1995 aged 16. Trevor had not wished to be placed at Hope Place at this point and was helped to find private accommodation, and employment in Dumfries.

In May he lost his employment and because of this soon after lost his accommodation. Trevor is estranged from his family.

Current Situation

Trevor approached Hope Place himself recently and was offered a bedsit at 1A on 21.05.96. Trevor is now well suited to Hope Place particularly as his accommodation is self contained. Trevor benefits a great deal from the advice and support he gets in relation to working with other agencies like skill-seekers and the DSS and also on a personal level. Trevor has applied to join the army in September this year.

Conclusion

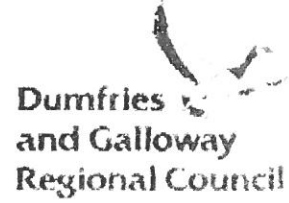


