
Since we did not meet as arranged at Ladyacre, Tony Haslitt asked that I offer you an opportunity to meet with me again.

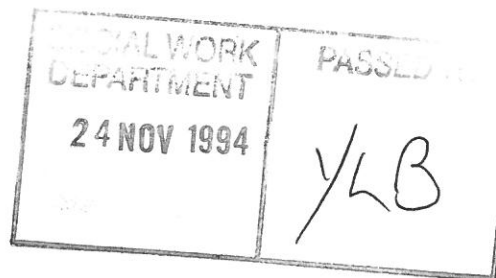

Haley and myself led Trevor from the lounge to his bedroom where we eventually got hold of the "joint".

1625. Trevor was not upset and said he would get his hands on more. He later said he had more cannabis and had ate it.

Young person's comments:

Trevor saw nothing wrong in bringing a "joint" into the unit. Big fuss about nothing is his opinion.

Unit Manager's comments/analysis:

I have warned Trevor that this type of behaviour will not be tolerated. I reminded him that if he chooses to break the law then he should face the consequences.

12.05am. There was a phone call from Ladyacre, Trevor had just handed himself in there. Staff from Ladyacre returned Trevor to the unit. On his return it appeared that he was under the influence of something and was asked to empty his pockets. A knife was found and confiscated, after a chat with myself and I. White Trevor retired to his bed.

The following morning, 28.11.94 Trevor informed a member of staff at Hightrees that he had been smoking cannabis. His attitude and behaviour was obnoxious and unco-operative, Trevor failed to comply with requests from staff. During a fire drill he refused to leave the building. It was only after numerous requests that he did eventually leave and only after punching one of the fire alarms off the wall, this was witnessed by M. Duff.

On returning to the unit Trevor pulled one of the emergency lights from the wall.

Since Trevor's admission he has failed to communicate with any member of staff at Hightrees. Sanctions have had virtually no effect towards improving his behaviour and any approach from staff to build a relationship with him is virtually knocked down before it has begun.

Trevor has given us this message from the start, he does not want staff at Hightrees to support or help him in any way.

Trevor was returned to the centre at 8.50pm by the Duty Social Worker and myself as escorts.

Trevor ran off outside and put his fist through the kitchen window. I was storming around the building searching for Trevor. I found Trevor outside and escorted him to his room. Trevor maintained that he didn't really know what had started the situation but said that I had been winding him up. He said he felt it was better to smash a window than to punch e. I left him in his room and went off in search of

Trevor demanded that he too wanted to visit Ladyacre, I said "no" as this was wholly inappropriate. Trevor was offered options e.g. snooker. He turned down everything. He ran from the building followed by I am unclear as to what happened next as I was then involved in another incident with

Trevor, who had eventually returned to the unit and smashed the fire glass in the boys corridor setting off the fire alarm. The broken glass was

replaced. According to staff some of the other residents were following Trevor round the building "pied piper" style. Staff were trying hard to divert, diffuse etc. but the residents were preferring to follow Trevor. Trevor then smashed the fire glass in the girls corridor setting off the fire alarm again. Obviously this increased the tension again.

Unit Manager's comments/analysis:

Trevor has stated that he wont be talking to anyone from Hightrees. He too, since his admission has constantly disregarded the few rules we have. He seems to want a "bed and breakfast" placement - coming and going as he chooses. He is not prepared to co-operate.

He took himself off outside and promptly threw a stone through the front office/staff room window - the stone and glass narrowly missed Mrs. Doak (Secretary) who was working in there at the time - she was obviously quite shaken and upset. Trevor then took himself upstairs into class obviously intent on causing maximum disruption - in and out of classrooms and winding everyone up.

N.B. Trevor had said to me earlier that his hand was sore - from punching windows. I suggested he go to hospital for an x-ray but he had just walked off.

J. Gibson (T.A.R.C.O) eventually managed to coax Trevor down from the classroom and he went with her to D&GRI, there are no broken bones in his hand.

and Trevor teamed up. There was a lot of whispering and going in and out of the building. They refused to talk with staff or stay in the one place. Both were getting quite "high" and it became obvious that the situation was not going to improve - and Trevor were "feeding" off each other.

I spoke with D. McKeever and then contacted R. Pagan and explained the situation. R. Pagan said that he or P. David would attend.

and Trevor then barricaded themselves in the pink lounge where they stayed for some time. Staff were outside the door but did not attempt to gain entry. They were obviously unhappy when left alone so they came out. Trevor started demanding his pocket money but given the situation I deemed it inappropriate. He started shouting, spitting and swearing and stormed off through towards the recreation room.

R. Pagan had arrived by this time and observed Trevor's behaviour. It was agreed that Trevor should be admitted to the secure suite. Trevor was taken in by B. Needham, G. Graham, T. Marshall and R. McMinn - R. Pagan was present when Trevor was struggling, kicking etc. - very violent - time 4.30pm.

I later learned that he'd punched and broken the observation window in his bedroom.

Trevor, since his admission, has indicated that he has no intention of co-operating with staff at Hightrees. He has attempted to do whatever he chooses, whenever he chooses, and is decidedly unhappy when thwarted. He revels in any disruption and is often the cause of disquiet.
