At times Mr Ferguson is at the end of his tether trying to get Marjory to keep her room tidy or have her clothes ready for washing. Mr Ferguson ~~finds~~ finds difficult appreciating that Marjory does still need help and encouragement to undertake these tasks. Mrs Ferguson is lazy around the house and also expects the children to successfully manage tasks that remain her responsibility. However although ~~this is a fairly major important aspect of the parental care.~~ Mr Ferguson's tolerance level is lower than it was towards the end of last year. He has threatened to send her back to Florence Booth at times and Marjory seems to be withdrawing slightly. Marjory may have some anxieties about the arrival of the new baby due in April.

Mr Jack at Rockwell School is very satisfied with Gavin and Marjorie's progress. They attend school regularly and are punctual, clean and tidy. Mr & Mrs Ferguson maintain good contact with school.

Gavin and Marjory returned home from Florence Booth Children's Home on 29th January 1984. Since their return home, Mr and Mrs Ferguson have had another child. Mr Ferguson was delighted the new baby was a boy. Concern existed about how Mr Ferguson would cope with the additional pressures of a young baby in the house in addition to the four other children, however Mr Ferguson has adapted well. Mr and Mrs Ferguson budget well and manage remarkably well on the supplementary benefit payments. Mr and Mrs Ferguson have responded very well to the work undertaken with them and generally their parenting skills are much improved although work along these lines is expected to continue with the family for several months.

Both Mr and Mrs Ferguson's relationships with their children are much improved although it is recognised that at times they expect too much of the children, eg. expecting a 5 year old to dress for school without help.

Hopefully, if the present progress continues, I would expect to request a Review Hearing in 1986 asking for Gavin and Marjory's Supervision Orders to be terminated. I would then expect to continue working with the family for a short while on a voluntary basis.

If the present progress continues, I would expect to recommend that Gavin, Marjory and [REDACTED] names be removed from the register at the next Review.

Home visit to Fergusons. Mr Ferguson, Gawin ^{Kenneth} ~~and~~ Sonia and two friends of Mr Ferguson present. Mrs Ferguson at berries with Marjory and Diane. Gawin is being kept off berries until Monday due to wandering away yesterday at berries.

House still cluttered and needing tidied. Mr Ferguson seems under pressure to some extent with Mrs Fergusons lack of effort in house. He is charged again on Wednesday for Road Traffic offence - no insurance, license, M.O.T. or Tax. - this is his third such offence one of which takes him to court next Wednesday. - Previous £75 payed - further fine expected on Wed, although possibility of custodial sentence cannot be dismissed (Checked this with Val Band, Court Team). As Wednesday draws nearer it is likely that pressure will build up in Mr Ferguson and overflow onto family especially when he is sitting as he is towards Mrs Ferguson. There is no doubt that a further visit will be needed prior to Wednesday and after Wednesday next week, to check out family pressure.

On this visit children seen, were happily playing although work needs to be done (when I return from leave) on Mr Ferguson involvement with the kids.

If Judi cannot visit next week I will visit twice during week. as Mr Ferguson will not take kindly to the presence of another worker, and this may further complicate family situation. Mentioned to Mr Ferguson that

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There is a possibility that Judi may be withdrawn from the family. Mr Ferguson passed this off as unimportant but appeared let down and surprised at this possibility. If Judi is to be withdrawn then I feel she should be allowed to make one further visit to finalise her contact with the family rather than just disappearing.

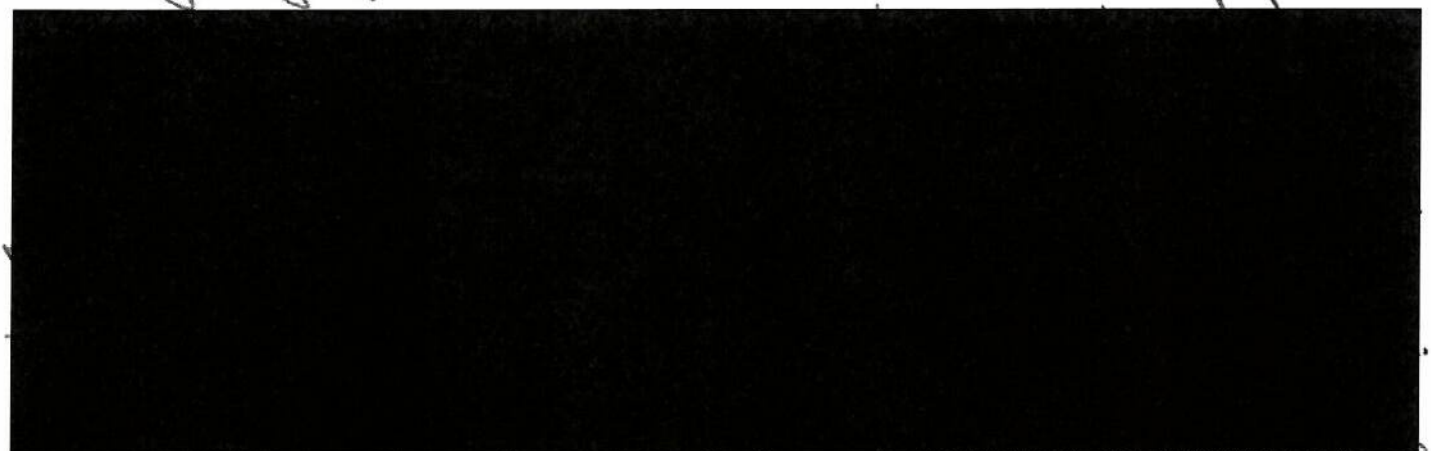
