Dear Mr. Baker,

I acknowledge receipt of your email and supporting documents re. the SAR for your client Mr. Michael Knight.

Although I can confirm that the De La Salle Brothers worked in the former St. Joseph's School, Tranent, at the time Mr. Knight resided, the School was not a 'De La Salle school'. There was a Brother as headteacher and Brothers on the staff along with others, but their status was that of employees. The De La Salle Brothers were not the employer, nor were they the Managers or Trustees of the School.

As a result, we do not hold any of the St. Joseph's School records in our archive – in particular, no pupil records.

Unfortunately, we are unable to state exactly where this information is to be found. We presume it is in Scotland but can only suggest that it might be lodged with either the National Records of Scotland, or the relevant Local Authority, or the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of St Andrews and Edinburgh who were the Trustees and appointed the Managers.
