28/08/2025 Substance misuse monitoring Andrew attended for face to face review this afternoon, arrived at agreed time. Looked well presented. Made good eye contact and spontaneous in conversation throughout review. Said he is doing okay. Reported that he stopped taking sertraline for a while as he believed that this was making his mood worse when first commenced, said he started taking it again three weeks ago. Agreed we will monitor and I will call him in a few weeks to discuss titration. No recent self-harm, no suicidal ideation disclosed. Told me that he hasn't used crack cocaine in over six months, no longer enjoys it and thinks it was detrimental to his health. No opiates in over a year. Said he hasn't used any illicit zopiclone/benzodiazapines for past few weeks as it has been difficult to source. Discussed sleep, said that he hasn't been having any nightmares recently. Does drink excessive amount of coffee 5-6 cups per day and three energy juice cans per day. Said he sometimes wakes during the night and has an energy juice. Sleep hygiene discussed. CMHN T.Airey

- Methadone 1mg/ml oral solution, 35ml daily consumed on premises
- Quetiapine 400mg modified release tablets, 1 tablet daily, dispensed daily
Dispensed from Bairds King Street

Next Appointment: 14/05/24 at 1100hr at Macrobin Centre

Risk:

- Drug use – crack cocaine
- Risk to mental health with drug use

Details of Contact:

Andrew attended for appointment. Appeared well kempt and no issues with mental state.

Denies any heroin use. Andrew is using crack cocaine a couple of times per month. He is aware of risks to mental health with crack use and is starting to think of it being more problematic for him. Andrew had been wanting to reduce methadone however as he missed last appointment prescription was just continued at current dose. Plan to reduce to 30ml methadone daily from 28/05/24. He is keen to switch over to Buprenorphine as soon as he can and I have provided information on how to do this as he would need to switch to Suboxone for a few weeks before commencing Buprenorphine. He says he has had Suboxone in past. Last LFT bloods were obtained in October and appear fine to enable switchover.

Andrew was unable to provide urine sample today we will hopefully get sample at next appointment which will be on 11/06/24 at 1130hr with Tammi Airey. If Andrew still keen to commence Suboxone he will have last dose of Methadone on 15/06/24 and will commence Suboxone on 17/06/24.

PLAN:

- Reducing methadone with view to switch to suboxone then buprenorphine
- Relapse prevention
- Harm reduction
- SOU
