Extract of Social Enquiry Report as found in SC36/60/175/23:

McChesney maintained strong links with friends in the Roystonhill area where the family had previously lived for about fifteen years and was socialising there prior to his admission to Springboig St John's

In February 1984 McChesney appeared before the Children's hearing for truancy and a number of minor misdemeanours. After a short period of assessment and an attempt to rehabilitate him from his home which proved unsuccessful, McChesney was admitted at the direction of the Children's Panel to Springboig St John's on 25 April 1984.

McChesney's career in Springboig St John's has been fairly up and down. He settled well initially but by the end of the summer his behaviour had deteriorated quite badly and culminated in the school dealing with him in a fairly rigorous way after a complete breakdown in relationships between himself and one of his instructors.

McChesney has now been in List 'D' School for ten months and in normal circumstances there was to be a recommendation to the Children's Panel that McChesney's supervision order be continued until at least his school leaving date.
