Thank you for your e-mail, we do not hold any information in relation to your client.

It is worth nothing that Rosyth is in Fife there is a Roseneath which is in Argyll and Bute Council's Area (Helensburgh and Lomond).

Historically there were a number of Residential School and or Care Homes within what is now Argyll and Bute Council's Area. Most were run by other organisations or by Glasgow Corporation which is now Glasgow City Council. Please see below information which might be useful.

Blairvadach House was run by Glasgow Burgh Council records will be held by Glasgow City Council however Blairvadach Childrens Home (bungalows) is still running and is owned by West Dunbartonshire Council

Caol Ruadh, Colintrave this was a residential home owned by Glasgow City Council from 1938 until around 1998. Records would be held either by Glasgow City or the placing authorities.

Cardross Assessment Centre, although Cardross does fall within the Argyll and Bute area now, historically, this would have been under Strathclyde Regional Council and subsequently West Dunbartonshire took over Cardross Assessment Centre. Again any records are likely to be held by the placing authority.

Dunclutha Children's home any child placed/living at Dunclutha prior to 1976 was the responsibility of the old Glasgow corporation who ran the home. Any request for access to records for that period should be made to Glasgow city council as the successor authority, Argyll and Bute will not have any records for that person/ period.

From 1976 – 1996 children were placed at Dunclutha from all over Strathclyde region and records will be held by the placing area – Renfrewshire, east or west Dunbartonshire etc.

St Andrew's Approved School was run from 1965 until 1986 by the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Glasgow. All records will be held by the placing authority.
