If you've had a flu vaccine since August 2025 (for example at school as a nasal spray, at work or at a pharmacy), you do not need to have another one this year, but you should still go to your appointment if you would like your COVID-19 vaccine. If you do not plan to have either vaccine, please cancel your appointment so that another person can take your place.
