Peter has kindly given us a supporting statement for your claim, which is a big help. Which brings us to our final steps in your claim.

Before we send it to the panel. We need to legally certify your documents; We need two kinds. A proof of address, this needs to be dated within 3 months, it can be a utility bill, NHS letter, council tax bill, HMRC letter. You can also use a bank statement, that needs to be dated no less than 6 months ago. We also need a proof of identity, driving licence, passport or the saltire card. We can certify these in a video call, I note that you don't use WhatsApp, which is what we use for video calling, you can add this quite simply on your mobile phone. You can also use the Post Office; you can take the originals and a photocopy of each document to them and they will certify them. There is a cost of £12.75, which we will reimburse for you. Please send them to Aiker Legal, 4a Edison Court, Elice Way, Technology Park, Wrexham, LL13 7YT.

We are very nearly there now.
