Thank you for all the details provided in your request which has helped greatly in searching for records. We have carried out searches within our Social Work Archives, Fife Council's Main Archives Unit (ONFife) and Education Service Archives for Mr Brolly and his siblings I'm very sorry to advise you that we have been unable to locate any records.

We believe that information may be held with Ayrshire Council (East Ayrshire Council, North Ayrshire Council and South Ayrshire Council) however appreciate that you may have tried them already. With regards to Starley Hall, unfortunately the earliest records we hold are from 1995 which mostly consists of Starley Hall's registration as a residential school. We have been unable to source any information for Mr Brolly.
