Good morning,

I can confirm receipt of the documents, including the large Glasgow social work file via the upload portal.

These have been added to Mr Caldwell's application, which we originally received on 07/11/2025.

Please note that we are currently facing a high volume of applications, so assigning a case worker is taking longer. It may be helpful to note we are currently assigning applications received in March 2025.

In the meantime, it would be helpful if you could please clarify information regarding the care setting noted in Mr Caldwell's application, now that records have been received.

On review of records, it looks like the placement for a period of

seven years Mr Caldwell refers to may have been a foster placement, although redactions make this unclear. If you or your client can provide any further information regarding the placement, this would be particularly helpful.

It may also be helpful to note that only abuse up to the date of 01 December 2004 will be considered by Redress Scotland, as per eligibility criteria:
