Thank you for your email requesting information on behalf of your client, Michael William Hannah.

The Scottish Children's Reporter Administration (**SCRA**) does not hold the information that you requested.

SCRA was established on 1 April 1996 and does not hold records prior to this date. Before the inception of SCRA, local authorities employed Children's Reporters and administered Children's Hearings. It may be worth contacting the relevant local authority to see if they hold any records prior to 1 April 1996 if you have not already done so.

All case information held by SCRA is destroyed when a referred individual reaches their 19th birthday to comply with data protection legislation. Prior to the incorporation of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child into Scots law on 16 July 2024, all case information was destroyed when a referred individual reached their 18th birthday.

In line with SCRA's Case Information Retention Policy and data protection legislation, SCRA no longer holds any information relating to Michael William Hannah.
