

- 1 The lease shall run from 22/01/2026 to 29/01/2026 and be renewed weekly thereafter.
- 2 The rent shall be £57.20 per day payable by installments weekly. Any other charges in respect of this let shall be paid on a similar basis and will be collected along with the rent. The sum payable weekly is presently £400.40. This charge includes a service charge, water and drainage charge and fuel charge. These charges shall be paid on a similar basis and will be collected along with the rent.
- 3 This tenancy is not a secure tenancy being specifically excluded in terms of Section 11(4) and Schedule 1, Paragraph 5 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 2001 as a house being let to the tenant expressly on a temporary basis for a term of less than 6 months, in fulfillment of a duty imposed on a local authority by Part II (homeless persons) of the 1987 Act.
- 4 The accommodation shall be occupied exclusively by the following persons: -

- 5 The occupant shall not permit any person not listed in Condition 4 to use the accommodation for sleeping without the permission of the Chief Executive.
- 6 Occupation shall continue until the Council has discharged its homeless duty. A Notice to Quit requiring vacant possession will be issued by Temporary Accommodation once homelessness duty has been discharged. A Notice to Quit may also be issued if the occupant, members of the household or visitors behave in an antisocial manner causing any nuisance, harassment (racial or otherwise) or disturbance to other occupiers, neighbours or those living in the vicinity of the premises; or if rent and service charge arrears are accrued by a failure to pay charges and/ or a failure to provide appropriate documentation to allow the process of a Housing Benefit application.
