What the Survivor shared with me

Peter has spoken about this incident many times since we met, he told me how he was and assaulted and restrained by a member of staff in Cardross secure unit.

This happened when he was going to make a cup of tea, and that the staff member wasn't happy about this and came at him from behind as he was walking into his bedroom.

Impact to the Survivor that I have observed

Peter has suffered from nightmares throughout our relationship, and this incident has always been at forefront when up through the night with these nightmares. I also know he tried antidepressants when he was younger, but they didn't agree with him, so he has just tried to get on with it himself.

Supporting Statement confirmation

I feel that the length of time peter spent in Cardross was unjust. This has definitely had a negative impact on his life, in the respect of feeling depressed, having nightmares and not sleeping.

I do hope this brings some closer for Peter.
