Following on from our letter dated 9 June 2026, I am writing to confirm that Redress Scotland has now arranged a date for your application for redress to be considered by a panel.

Your application will be considered on 3 July 2026.

We are not anticipating any change to these arrangements, but if for any reason the panel are not able to meet on this date we will notify you as soon as possible through your Scottish Government caseworker.

All Redress Scotland panel members are appointed by Scottish Ministers. You can find more information about our Panel Members at www.redress.scot/about-redress-scotland/our-people.

We recognise that this period can be difficult and stressful for many survivors and that you may have some anxieties about the sitting day. Support is available to you through the Redress Support Service. If you would like to speak to someone about support please contact your caseworker on 0808 175 0808 (freephone).

After the panel sitting day, the panel members will write a letter to let you know their decision and the reasons they made the decision. They may need to ask you for more information at that point. They will also provide information about next steps. This letter will be sent to your Scottish Government caseworker usually within 5 working days of the panel date. Your caseworker will then forward it on to you and you should receive it shortly afterwards.
