

29/07/2002	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: Claire asking for permission to stay at friends, [REDACTED] tonight. Agreed I would speak with Ailsa Williams. Ailsa advised that Claire has stayed at [REDACTED] previously but that last week had been on drugs there. Ailsa also due to see Claire tomorrow. Discussion with Claire who was by now back at Kilmuir Road. Advised her that she should remain there tonight and that Sw would be seeing her in the a.m. Claire appeared to accept this. Further call from Claire around 10.20p.m. now requesting that she stay with [REDACTED] on leave and staying at sister [REDACTED]. Given late hour advised Claire that I was not happy to be authorising arrangements this late in the day and advised her to return to Kilmuir Road as arranged. Claire informed me that she would not return and was told that she would be reported missing to police if she did not return. Staff at Kilmuir Road advised to notify police if Claire not back by 11p.m. Further call from Claire to ask if she could stay out till 11p.m. Advised Claire to be back in the house for 11p.m. which she agreed to. Claire was reported missing to police but turned up a short time later. (All calls from Claire through the operator).</p>
27/07/2002	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: Claire admitted last night drunk with superficial lacerations. FP Elma Rogers stayed with her until 3am. Still asleep. Eileen asking as to plan for Claire as she understands she isn't returning to Rogers. T/c to Isabel MacLennan. Sup. Wkr is Karen Macdonald. T/c to Karen. Advised her Claire in Raigmore. Karen a bit vague as to what happens after she admits Claire to Kilmuir Rd. T/c to Wendy Lowrie. Plan for Claire to be accommodated until Tuesday. Karen will look after her until 5pm when Suzanne Gumbrell will take over. Wendy will confirm this with Karen. T/c to Raigmore. Claire still asleep. Nursing staff want to see her up and eating before discharge. They will call this Service when she is ready to be discharged. She will need clean clothes. T/c to Karen to advise. T/c from Elma Rogers who recapped events of previous night etc. Notes that Claire had a terrible thirst drank litre of ice water. Advised that Karen Macdonald would be up to get her clothes. T/c from Ch's. Wd. Claire now up and about; washed and fed etc. Becoming defiant. T/c to Karen; she will go and get her and take her to Kilmuir Rd.flat. T/c from Karen; she is with Claire at FP's Petula Falconer. Claire wants to take her music centre to Kilmuir Rd. Agreed this was ok as it was best that her possessions were all in one place.</p>
27/07/2002	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: Claire who left the unit at 1700 returned by police at 2025 in intoxicated state having been at home of [REDACTED] where police were in attendance at an incident (not directly involving C). She went to bed but staff concerned she may have taken more than alcohol and sought advice. After discussion agreed worker would check on her during the evening and if any cause for alarm regarding her condition medical assistance to be sought. 2107 T/c from Rikki Selkirk. He had contact with worker who was suspicious of friend [REDACTED] who called to see C and left quickly after which C locked her door. Agreed with Rikki that staff would continue with plan to open door and check on C. Later advised that staff did access C who admitted to taking various kinds of alcohol. At that time all calm. MB 28/07 Sup. Wkr, Karen Macdonald reported that Claire had gone out; she agreed to meet up with Suzanne at 5pm. MJG</p>
06/07/2002	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: Referred at morning handover. Standby SW Jim Low going to collect Claire from Mrs Lundie. No reply yet from Petula Falconer. T/c to Petula and left a message on her answering service. I had to divert Jim Low to another client. Mrs Lundie agreed to keep Claire until 12 noon. 1050 I visited Petula's home and got no answer. Elma Rodgers agreed to look after her until Petula returned home. Yvonne Lundie took Claire to Mrs Rodgers. AMF 18.15 T/c from Petula Falconer. She said that she had received a call from a friend of Claire at 22.15 last night. The friend said that Claire was fine and staying the night with her. Petula reluctantly agreed to have Claire return to her, but said that she would be "grounded" tonight and that if she then left the house, she would not be able to return. T/c Elma Rodgers. Dougie will return Claire. T/c Elma to ask if she could have Claire tonight should situation break down She agreed. 19.40 t/c from Petula Falconer. Claire has left the house. She reported her as missing to Police immediately. I followed with a phone call informing Police of address to which Claire would be returned. 2120 T/c from Police. They have found Claire and are taking her to Rodgers'. T/c Dougie to inform. MB Sunday 07/07/02. Morag Brown arranged for Claire to stay with the Rodgers tonight, given reluctance of Petula Falconer to have her back following latest runaway.</p>

10/05/2002	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: See advance message same date. Claire has missed the last bus from Inverness. Agnes called her mobile number 07961 021455 and got Claire's friend who said Claire was going to stay with her tonight. I advised Agnes to report Claire missing to AIness police and let them know she is in Inverness. T/c to Claire. When I told her she was being reported missing, she said she would return to the placement if I sent out a social worker to fetch her. I said that I would not do that for reasons to do with the safety and time of the social worker. I said that I would arrange her return to the placement once the police advised me she was at the station. I suggested she turn herself in to Burnett Road. She refused, saying she did not want to spend the night in a cell. I explained that she would be there no longer than it took the social worker to arrive unless she was in some sort of trouble. After discussing the same issues several times, Claire ended the call. 11/05/02 00.02 T/c from Agnes Brooks. The police had just left her house after taking a statement. I advised her about above conversation. 11/05/02 02.27 T/c from Agnes seeking update. I told I had heard nothing further.</p>
11/12/2001	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: It's believed Claire has gone away with [REDACTED] after visiting her. Believed to have gone to Clachnachudden Social Club. T/c to Eliz Brown. Claire not back. Eliz will give her till midnight and report her to Police. 1202 T/c from Police control. They have Claire; they have contacted Eliz Brown and she says she won't have her back, T/c to Eliz. She confirmed this. We discussed as to why she has suddenly decided this as when I had spoken to her earlier she had only spoken in general terms of the placement needing to end. Eliz. became quite heated and said she didn't like my manner. Tried to get her to appreciate it was so difficult to find alternative care at this time of night. Eliz adamant that she won't have her back she feels she has been led along for too long. At the recent review she was told another placement was being sought but nothing had happened. Offered to have Claire taken away first thing tomorrow. Eliz.refused this. Suggested she may regret acting so impulsively T/c to Craigton Ave. Mary Corbett agreed to have her. Police are on their way to the flat. 20.10 T/c from Sgt [REDACTED]. Claire is at Baird Street Police Office. T/c Mr and Ms Rodgers to inform. Message left on answering machine. T/c Tracey MacKintosh to inform. T/c Sgt [REDACTED]. Claire appears to be well. I informed Sgt [REDACTED] that staff would be leaving Inverness at approximately 21.00 hrs to go to Glasgow to collect Claire. T/c Kate Birch. Arrangements finalised. 25/10/2001	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: 22.10 hrs While dealing with the matter of another child who had made her way to Glasgow on the 'bus, I became aware that Claire was accompanying her. 22.10 t/c Dougie Rodgers to inform. Several more calls with Dougie, who feels that he cannot continue to look after Claire. T/c Tracey MacKintosh to inform. Mb 07788482236. Message left with Tracey's partner. 26/10/01 01.00hrs t/c from Tracey who gave me mb number of a friend, [REDACTED], who lives in [REDACTED], Glasgow. Street number nor surname known. [REDACTED]. 07.50hrs T/c to above number. Answering service. I did not leave a message. 07.55 t/c from Dougie Rodgers - nothing heard. 08.10 T/c Stewart Street Police Station, 0141 532 3000, to clarify whether Claire has been reported as missing. No report. T/c Resource Desk, Burnett Road. Spoke with [REDACTED] who took details and will pursue matter. T/c Dougie Rodgers to alert him that Police will be in touch regarding missing person report.</p>

23/10/2001	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: Claire called Mrs Rodgers saying someone told her she was reported missing. Advised had no knowledge that she was missing & expect to have information if that were the case. The Rodgers are expecting C back tonight. 1826 T/c from Veronica MacKenzie at 49 Craigton Ave. where C visiting with another LAC. Veronica asking that R's to collect C. T/c to Mrs R who said that C has rover ticket and capable of returning by bus. T/c to Veronica and C. C insisted she was returning to placement on the 2200 bus. Veronica had advised her she could stay at Craigton Ave. for half an hour only. She was concerned that the other girl would go away with C if she insisted on her going for the bus. T/c to Mrs R who agreed to try and collect C. 1944 T/c from Veronica. C would not be persuaded to go with Mrs R. She then went out with the other child. 1952 T/c from Mrs R. C told her she intended to return on the 2200 bus. 2230 T/c from Mrs R. No sign of C. She agreed to report her missing. 2311 T/c from Sgt [REDACTED]. Police found C. Refuses to return to placement. Interviewed C at Burnett Rd, 0010 on 24.10. After expressing reluctance she appeared to accept that there was no alternative placement tonight. Police returned her to placement. C said that Mr R sometimes drinks too much and shouts at her. Told her that I would speak to Mrs Rodgers and advise that she be allowed to go quietly to bed and would ask Claire's Swr. to contact Claire first thing on Wednesday morning. 16/10/2001	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: Mr Rodgers advising that Claire supposed to be at a Ch's Hearing today @ 1615 but didn't turn up. A warrant was issued by the Hearing and if police find her, as she's also reported missing by carer, they will hold her until an available Hearing. 2018 T/c from [REDACTED], friend of [REDACTED] asking if Claire posted missing. Advised would not discuss with her. Spoke to Claire who advised she had contact with Swr. today and arranged to meet tomorrow. Advised understood she was reported missing and police would be looking for her. 2029 T/c from Mr Rodgers who advised he'd been called by [REDACTED] asking him to let police know that Claire not now missing and that she was safe with [REDACTED]. Mr Rodgers advised that police would be seeking to speak to her as usual when she'd been reported missing. He advised that he'd notified police of her whereabouts. 2244 T/c from Sgt [REDACTED]. Claire detained. Police clearly saying police office not place of safety for a child and seeking to have her placed elsewhere. Eventually negotiated her return to Mr and Mrs Rodgers. Rikki Selkirk Snr.SCW returned Claire c.0030 to the Rodgers'. She apparently went straight to bed. Claire needs seen early a.m. on Wed. 17.10 re appearance at Ch's Panel. Reporter needs to be notified.</p>
20/08/2001	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: Request for SW to attend police interview. Claire and [REDACTED] have been picked up and being interviewed on suspicion of theft. Advised would contact the Rodgers who Claire is staying with at present. T/c to Dougie Rodgers who will attend for interview. 2300 T/c from Dougie to say he had just returned from the Police station as the police officer dealing with Claire had not been available and therefore the interview has yet to take place. Dougie was also told by the police that a Swr. on their way so Dougie presumed he could return home. T/c to Sgt [REDACTED] who explained that the officer had been unable to be available as involved elsewhere. Sgt [REDACTED] will speak with on call Swr. when she arrives and advise her of situation. 2330 T/c from Jenny Walker to say that C has been interviewed. She stated that she was unwilling to return to Rodgers but gave no reason for this. Jenny has advised Claire that she'll have to return to the Rodgers tonight. Police will return Claire when they have someone available. Claire returned and nothing further heard.</p>

26/06/2001	History - SSID Enquiry Notes	<p>SSID Enquiry Details: Initial ref at 2350 on 25.6.01. Dougie advised that Elma went to Raigmore Hospital to collect Claire who'd been taken there by Police under the influence of alcohol. Asked Dougie to get Elma to phone if there were any further issues/problems. 0440 Elma phoned to say that she'd just returned from the hospital and that Claire being kept in overnight. Claire may have also taken tablets. The hospital are taking bloods to check. Claire had gone to a friend's [REDACTED] earlier to stay the night. However it would seem that Kelly then went to the house of a [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] Leyton Drive. Another female [REDACTED] was present and a blind man, name unknown. [REDACTED] had contacted the Police at 2330 to say that she and her friend [REDACTED] had cut their wrists. When Police arrived Claire also found. Craig Inshes staff also able to check their computer for father and informed me that a Gordon MacRae in Glen Ochil prison (01259 760 471).
