PROGRESS NOTES

Monthly Case Summary

November 1999

Stewart is 16 yrs and currently resides in Kibble. His placement will not meet his needs to prepare for independent living, given the lack of availability of places in the Independent Living Unit within Kibble. Stewart initially planned to return to the family home, however following an incident, this is no longer an option. Stewart attends Reid Kerr College on a full time basis on an N.C. course in Sport & Recreation.

Contact with Stewart has been maintained by placement visit. A Throughcare Plan has been devised for Stewart on 5.11.99 (see file). Stewart has started attending the Throughcare Preparation Group in which he is a keen participant of groupwork sessions. On the 25.11.99 I accompanied Stewart and Norma Bell s.w. on an introductory visit to Raisdale as a possible future placement.

December 1999

Contact with Stewart has been maintained by placement visits. On the 6.12.99, I was advised by Norma Bell s.w. that funding has been approved for Raisdale. I accompanied Stewart and his mother to Raisdale, Stewart is looking forward to being accommodated there as he has been identified as suitable for joining the semi-independent unit immediately instead of having to be in the assessment unit first. A planning meeting was held in Raisdale with Stewart, Norma Bell s.w., Andrea McGill (Ayrshire Throughcare) and the writer, where it has been decided that Stewart will commence his placement in Raisdale after spending his Christmas break at his mother's. Stewart has now completed the preparation group programme successfully.

January 2000

Contact with Stewart has once again been maintained by placement visits. I have been advised by David Finnegan (D.Manager), that Stewart has settled fairly well into his placement at Raisdale, although he is now spending a fair amount of time at his uncle's home in Ferguslie. Stewart has been unable to attend a planned trip to Italy with his college placement due to the fact that he has a fractured wrist. Stewart has also been advised by Reid Kerr College that he is not being allowed to sit his Bronze Lifesaving Exam due to his non - attendance over the last few weeks, I have also been advised by his course tutor (Isobel Drysdale), that his overall behaviour has also been a significant factor as to his suitability for this course, as a direct result Stewart intends giving up his course at this college.

February 2000

There has been no contact with Stewart this month, due to Stewart cancelling visits. Another meeting between Stewart, myself and Tom Ballantyne (N. Ayrshire Throughcare) scheduled for the 29.2.00 was cancelled as Stewart has moved back into his parental home. I telephoned Stewart at his mother's on the 29.2.00 where Stewart has advised that he will be staying with his mum as relationships have much improved. I advised Stewart to contact either myself or Throughcare in Ayrshire if he required any advice or guidance in the future.

Areas of concern as indicated in residential review form:

Stewart needs to have a throughcare plan in place soon, to prevent anxiety and an increase in drink/drugs intake.

Areas of concern as indicated in Social Worker's form:

Family - That Stewart can no longer return to the family home to live in preparation for independent living.

Particular reference to child being accommodated - Stewart has maintained his attendance on his Leisure and Recreation course at Reid Kerr College, Paisley. He has complied with day leave arrangements with Kibble and does not present a management problem. Stewart acknowledges his part in the breakdown of relationships with his mother.

Summary of Discussion:

Paperwork Available - Social Worker's Form D, Looked After Review Report from Mossedge North Unit, Child in Care Review - Client's Report and Memo from Isobel Drysdale (Senior Lecturer, Reid Kerr College).

Mary Francey opened the meeting and following formal introductions explained that the meeting had been convened in light of major changes in Stewart's circumstances which has

called Care Start, which works with youngsters in terms of education, employment and training and if felt appropriate, she could arrange a joint visit to discuss Stewart's situation in more detail. She also explained that the bursary situation has been a common problem with young people and the project is working on ways around it. Meantime, there may be additional funding that could be accessed to prevent Stewart having to give up his college placement - an issue which could be explored over the next week. Certainly assistance has been given in the past towards books, materials, fares etc to encourage continued education.

Stewart was unsure if securing funding would make a difference to his decision but agreed to think about it. He admitted he wants to work and have something to do but recognised gaining a qualification would also offer him more opportunities in terms of employment in the future.

Margaret Fitzpatrick was invited to the meeting in view of Stewart's stated preference of remaining in the Paisley area and indeed had indicated to Ms Duncan that he would be worried about returning to the Three Towns area because he couldn't see himself being able to stay out of trouble. Ms Fitzpatrick was willing for her team to become involved with Stewart and informed him that they currently work with a number of young people who live independently but also continue to attend college courses, some of whom even receive benefits at the same time. The Throughcare Team in Paisley have the use of two hostels, a couple of flats and some carers in the area which are all obviously in great demand. Once identified, Stewart's worker will need to meet with him to see what he is actually looking for and do an assessment based on that. They also have a preparation group starting next week which is scheduled to run for ten weeks and involves different speakers etc. This group will consist of other young people who are in the same position as Stewart and plan to stay in the Paisley area. Stewart agreed he would attend.

In terms of timescales for a Children's Hearing, Ms Bell advised that as soon as an appropriate package has been put together that Stewart is willing to co-operate with and that will give an adequate level of support she can request a Hearing for consideration to be given to terminating the Supervision Order.

At this point in the meeting, there being no further issues to be addressed, Mrs Francey summarised the discussion and brought the meeting to a close.

Decisions taken (specifying action to be taken and by whom):

1. Stewart to remain in Kibble School, however, Workers from both North Ayrshire Throughcare and the Paisley Throughcare Team to begin working with Stewart to discuss the supports and services that can be offered in terms of independent living, further education, employment etc. Norma Bell and Gerry Daly to continue to support Stewart as appropriate.
 2. Children's Hearing to be convened once an appropriate package of support is in place to consider terminating Stewart's Supervision Requirement Order.

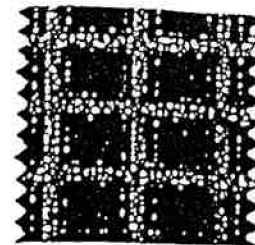
On the whole, I hope his present attitude to College continues to allow him success within his study.

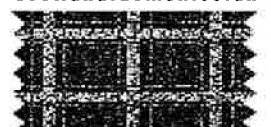

DECISIONS OF LAST REVIEW

1. Stewart to remain at Kibble School.
2. Return home to be facilitated in the short term.
3. Gerry to support this with fortnightly home visits.
4. Stewart to continue college placement.

UPDATE ON THESE DECISIONS

- A. Stewart remains at Kibble.
- B. Stewart's leave has broken down following an incident. He has no contact and return home is no longer an option.
- C. Visits have been halted as a result of B.
- D. College placement continues.

PROGRESS IN NORTH UNIT

Stewart's behaviour and attitude remain manageable. He is somewhat 'down' because of circumstances. Occasionally confrontational in the unit, but generally is able to accept reasonable explanations.

HOME LEAVE PROGRAMME/FAMILY CONTACT

Home leave was progressing with the aim of a return home on a permanent basis about or before Christmas. Fortnightly meetings between Stewart, his mum and Gerry were being used to deal with issues. On 2/3 October however, Stewart was removed from his Aunt Joanne's house during a family party, where he had become very drunk and aggressive. He was charged with BOP. Mrs Pullar has now withdrawn from all contact and has intimated that she will not re-open the door.

AREAS OF STRENGTH

Stewart continues to attend College.

His relationship with peers and staff are usually harmonious.

He has a high standard of personal hygiene and takes care of his appearance.

AREAS OF CONCERN

Stewart needs to have a throughcare plan in place soon, to prevent anxiety and an increase in drink/drugs intake.

OUTSIDE AGENCY INVOLVEMENT (IF APPROPRIATE)

Throughcare. Reid Kerr College (Mrs Drysdale).

HEALTH

Attending fitness and leisure course. Stewart is healthy and aware of health issues. Continues to smoke.

CARE PLAN GOALS

SHORT TERM:

Continue college placement.
Remain at Kibble.
Explore throughcare options.

MEDIUM TERM

Explore throughcare options.
Identify, implement and support alternative accommodation.

LONG TERM:

Establish independent identity as soon as possible. Stewart is very reluctant to continue working with statutory agencies.

NIGHT CARE OFFICER'S REPORT

Stewart sleeps well and seems to rise refreshed. No difficulties at night.
