I am writing in response to a data rights request you made to NRS on behalf of your client, Joanne McKenna. This was passed to the Scottish Government as we are the data controller of some files which were relevant to the scope of your request.

Following a search by the Care Experience and Whole Family Wellbeing Division we have confirmed that we do not hold any records in relation to Ms McKenna.

I appreciate that this will be disappointing for your client. However, National Records Scotland will respond to you directly to inform you of the results of the search of their records and may be also in the position to provide details of other public bodies who may hold information relating to your request.
