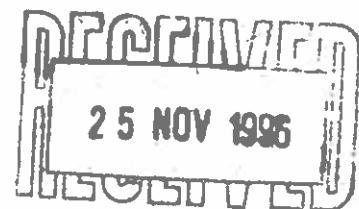

SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

██████████ Senior Social Worker, opened the Review with introductions, and an explanation that the meeting would require to look at Richard's situation, in terms of his health, school, behaviour and access.

██████████ Social Worker, reported that there continue to be no major concerns in terms of Richard's health. He has now entered Primary 5 in Balmuildy Primary School, where he appears to be progressing well. Access has been typified by gaps, but averages out quite well. However, periods of gaps as long as two weeks, are less than helpful to Richard. ██████████ has spoken to Richard about being in Kenmure for some further time, and Richard appears to be accepting of this. He asked Alan if he would still be in Kenmure at Christmas. Cathy is now living once again with ██████████, at his address. She moved in there around the beginning of August. Cathy is still disqualified from getting a tenancy of her own, but should qualify for this after the 20th October.

██████████ Keyworker, confirmed that Richard's health has been good, and he has not needed to use his inhaler. He is a very active little boy who is always on the go. In terms of school, ██████████ reported that since returning after the summer holidays, Richard has been doing fine, although he still forgets to bring his homework books home. He now travels on the school bus himself, and Kenmure have had no complaints. School contacts say things are fine at the moment. Academically Richard is keeping up with the class, and there have been no behavioural problems in the playground or in class. This is a reflection of how things are in Kenmure for him in that Richard is getting on much better with staff, and appears less aggressive with other young residents, looking to staff to help sort out any problems he has. Richard is described as a loving boy with a bubbly personality who has loads of energy and loves to play outside on the unit bike, or at football. Overall, his behaviour has improved and he is able now to accept responsibility for his actions.

There was a lengthy discussion, in terms of the quality and quantity of access between Richard and his mother, and it was noted that when access takes place on a regular basis this is beneficial to Richard. He also enjoys contact with his sister and brother, Kirsty and Christopher, and looks forward to seeing his extended family, when he has the opportunity to visit his grandparents on a Saturday. He also has fairly regular telephone contact with his family. It was however acknowledged, that gaps of up to 2 weeks in access, are not beneficial for Richard, and, while he does not exhibit any major overt signs of being distressed when his mother doesn't appear, it is felt that this is likely to be having a covert effect on him emotionally.

It should be noted, that Cathy became quite upset early on in the meeting, and left the room for a period of time. After some discussion, with ██████████, and then with ██████████ Cathy managed to compose herself and returned and took a full part in the meeting. It is acknowledged, that Cathy does find these meetings very difficult to deal with, and it is to her credit that she has been attending recent Reviews, and taking a fuller part in the meetings.

The Review members including Cathy, agreed that Richard should remain in Kenmure for a further period of time, and that that should be the recommendation to the forthcoming Children's Hearing on the 17th September. Access will be at the rate of a minimum of three days per week, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, and other access can be arranged with Kenmure. Cathy agreed to phone Kenmure if access needs to be cancelled for any reason. Residential staff agreed to arrange for Richard's annual medical. Cathy also agreed to pursue her housing situation after the 20th October and it was agreed that the next Child in Care Review would take place at 12 o'clock on the 3rd December 1996 within Kenmure Cottages.

Summary of Discussion

██████████ Senior Social Worker, opened the meeting with introductions, and an explanation that today's meeting would look at amongst other things, Richard's health, school, progress/behaviour in Kenmure, access, and future plans.

Richard was reported to be in good health. He has a new inhaler, although he does not require to use this to often.

██████████ reported that Richard goes readily to school, and appears to enjoy wearing his school uniform, and having a nice tidy presentable appearance. This is in contrast to when he was in his own clothes, when he has reported to enjoy being scruffy, and borrowing other children's clothing. In terms of his behaviour within school, ██████████ reported that Richard was still presenting some difficulties in the playground. Academically, he is functioning at a level appropriate for his age. Kenmure staff have a set of Richard's school books in the cottage in case he leaves any of his books in school.

Richard's mother expressed concern about his bullying of other children. ██████████ and ██████████ both explained that this issue is being addressed, and that the underlying difficulty would appear to be that Richard has a tendency to react to confrontation with his fists. There is said to be improvement however, in this problem, both within Kenmure and within the school.

██████████ and ██████████ both reported that Richard is progressing and developing well within Kenmure. His behaviour is also improving, and he responds well when spoken to about his behaviour. As in all areas of his life, Richard responds well to a consistent approach from all the adults who are concerned with his welfare.

██████████ reported that the quality of access since April has noticeably improved, and that Richard has enjoyed this. Alan had some concerns that the pattern of access may be too flexible, in that Richard's mother sometimes visits on days other than those which have been prearranged. ██████████ agreed that this does sometimes happen, but that Richard although disappointed, does not react to adversely to this. ██████████ agreed, that Richard enjoys his contact with his mother, and appears relaxed about her visiting.

Richard's mother is now attending the School Projects parents group.

██████████ has contact with Richard on a weekly basis. He reported that Richard can be challenging, to present contradictory behaviour, and push limits. Alan has found that it is better to make firm decisions for him. Alan has found Richard to be a likely wee boy, who relates well when out on trips with ██████████ and ██████████ (another young client of ██████████).

Richard recently had one weeks holiday in Aviemore, with Kenmure, and he is said to have enjoyed this very much, and presented no difficulties whilst there.

Richard's mother requested that he be allowed home for overnights. This was discussed at some lengths, but her request was ultimately refused, given that in the week prior to this meeting, an incident had occurred within Richard's grandmothers house, where the other children were left unattended. This incident is the subject of a referral to the Children's Hearing, in terms of the other children.

The Review members discussed the lack of stability which continues in Richard's home circumstances, and concluded that Richard should remain in care for a further period of time. Richard's mother did not disagree with this.

It should be noted, that in the early part of the meeting, Richard's mother left the Review for a period of time, saying that she did not like what was being discussed. She did return to the meeting however and took full part in the rest of the discussions.
