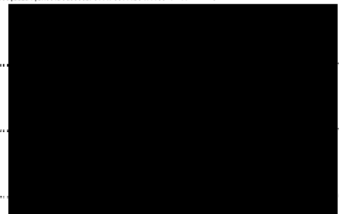

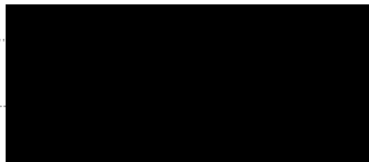

When writer spoke with Richey about this he advised that this boy is his friend & admitted to using the card once. Richey will repay 1 lot of faves £6 from his pocket money - see repayment log. * Richey advised that he needs to put all of the clothes away which are on the floor. Offered to help him. Richey refused this help. He's been advised that he will not get his pocket money until this task has been carried out.

after school Richey given 15mins t/o for refusing to complete t/o & aggressive attitude. Richey also has t/o to complete from earlier. Richey very unhappy about situation & chose to leave the building. I followed but Richey apparently wanted to play crossing games. I advised Richey of consequences i.e. time out and that should he choose to run around all evening he would lose leave tomorrow. Richey threw something at white van [redacted]. 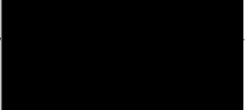

Richard up and out to his hearing with writing. This was a particularly difficult hearing a [redacted] was confronted with her alcohol use of late and lack of food etc in the home by Richey. Richey managed the hearing in a very mature way and coped exceptionally well with [redacted] loud and disruptive behaviour throughout.

Decision is for Richard to remain in St Philip's School and plans to begin being made for his long-term future interests of career and place of habitation. Richey is open to discussion. An early review will be requested and an HMR will take place, hopefully prior to this. The lack of an allocated worker on Richey's behalf has also been practised by the hearing. I took Richey for a burger afterwards and although visibly upset Richard is able to accept that his mother's behaviour is her responsibility, not his. [redacted] will look into Richard having contact with other family members including his father. I have spoken with Richey about the potential difficulties he may have to face in this respect as he has had very little contact ever with his father. Richey accepts this but is hopeful that some relationship may be built.
