Despite verbal & non-verbal interventions Richey threatened [redacted] & attempted to assault [redacted] who had come into the kitchen area. Ultimately Richey had to be held due to further attempts to assault [redacted]. Richey sustained a bump to the head and a scratch on his chin. LSI carried out by [redacted] & [redacted]. Richey admitted that his difficulty was due to a comment made by his mother this morning. (See incident report) [redacted]
