Vandalism Offences:

- Vandalism/Criminal Damage: he was sentenced to 60 days in a Young Offenders Institution (YOI) for these offences.

As a result, he spent much of his childhood in residential care placements (REDACTED). He was placed under Children's Hearing supervision for many years and frequently ran away from care settings. Mr. Irvine briefly returned to live with (REDACTED) but this arrangement was short lived. Afterward, he experienced a period of insecure living, moving between various relatives' homes and homelessness settings, and spent several short periods in a Young Offender Institution.

Mr. Irvine's education began in state mainstream schools, but he ultimately completed his schooling at St. Philips residential school, where he was placed under a Children's Hearing supervision order.
