What the Survivor shared with me

I'm writing this to confirm that I was aware of the homes that George was placed in as a child. He was in St Ninians Home for boys from 1967 – 1970, he was also put in St Jospeh's Tranent. He told me all about the abuse that happened at the homes. The behaviour of the staff. He wet the bed and was made to stand outside in a nightshirt. He was made to take cold showers in the middle of the night. He was beaten black and blue. George still talk about the memories, and they were not good at all.

Impact to the Survivor that I have observed

George has trouble sleeping and will frequently wake up screaming. What happened to George in his childhood has haunted him for all his life.
