Thank you for your Subject Access Request regarding the records of Edward Dillon and his time at Nazareth House.

I have searched all the surviving registers and records and found the following records

Edward Dillon was admitted to Nazareth House Aberdeen on **22 November 1967**. He stayed there until **6 March 1972**, when he transferred to Nazareth House Kilmarnock. He stayed at Kilmarnock until **2 May 1972**.

There are records for Edward in the Children's registers for both Aberdeen and Kilmarnock. I have transcribed the information from the registers below and also attach a redacted copy.
