Further to our initial submission on **10/03/2026** please find attached the pro forma and final components of the Redress Scotland application case number **APP360577** on behalf of a survivor of historical abuse in care.

We can confirm our client does not have a terminal illness and has no relevant previous criminal convictions. You will note that the certified documents are signed by Matthew Reynard.

Inverclyde response

- Mr Crawford was cared for under Greenock Council and as Inverclyde council are the successor to Greenock they would be considered the placing authority for Mr Crawford.
- We therefore submitted a subject access request to Inverclyde council.
- Document 6.5 contains Inverclyde's response in which they confirm they hold early care record evidence for Mr Crawford but do not hold records of later residence which was likely destroyed by a fire in 2002.

Evidence Files

- Documents 7 "DSAR evidence Inverclyde" and 7.1 "DSAR evidence Nazareth House" were too large to be sent over email. I have therefore uploaded these documents to the

online portal. Please confirm receipt of these files.

Care Timeline

- Mr Crawford was in and out of care from birth until the age of 16. For this reason, I have attempted to set out a care timeline in document 5.
- This timeline is based on the care record evidence we have received and our conversations with Mr Crawford regarding his time in care.
