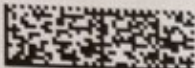

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What Carer Support Payment is

Carer Support Payment is a weekly payment for carers who live in Scotland. This is in recognition of the important work they do as a carer.

If you get severe disability premium

Severe disability premiums help with the cost of care. Your severe disability premiums will stop if Michelle gets Carer Support Payment. Michelle will get money to care for you from Carer Support Payment instead.

- income-based Job Seeker's Allowance
- Income Support
- Pension Credit
- Housing Benefit
- Council Tax Reduction
