DIABETIC EYE SCREENING RESULT

Thank you for attending your recent diabetic eye screening test.

The results of your eye screening show that you have no diabetic changes to your eye(s).

Your next test is due in two years. We will send you a reminder letter nearer the time. We have informed your GP of your test result and you should talk to them if you have any concerns about your diabetes.

You should continue to concentrate on controlling your diabetes as well as possible. This will reduce the risk of diabetic eye disease progressing.

You will be sent your next appointment in accordance with the result above. Your GP Practice will be informed of your result via the SCI-DIABETES Network.
