

Evidence Extraction Sheet

Ashley Young - social-work and residential-care records

Scope: proof of placement, legal status, admission/discharge, temporary leave, named professionals, direct abuse evidence, impact and contradictory/neutral material. Page references are PDF page numbers.

Headline findings

Placement eligibility: The records provide direct evidence of foster and residential placements before 1 December 2004, including Woodside Terrace, a foster placement with Margo Thomson, and the Good Shepherd Centre, Bishopton. The strongest admission date is 16 September 1999.

Direct abuse evidence: No clear direct description of physical abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, or a contemporaneous abuse complaint by Ashley was identified in the pages reviewed. Behavioural descriptions and statements that she disliked a person at the Centre have not been treated as proof of abuse.

Legal basis: The material refers to Place of Safety warrants, Children's Hearings, Home Supervision Requirements, and recommendations/conditions of residence naming the Good Shepherd Centre.

Important limitation

These files are predominantly scanned records. The highlighted copies mark pages containing relevant placement, legal-status, leave, review and discharge material. The highlight may cover a full evidence block rather than only individual words. Unclear OCR wording has been described conservatively and should be checked against the scanned page before quotation in an application.
