Q1 | What is the name or location of the relevant care setting you were abused in?

Q4 | On the next page, please provide as much information as you can about:

- the abuse you experienced while living in this care setting
- what life was like for you during this time
- how the people responsible for your care and welfare failed to carry out that duty (within or beyond your care setting)

You can continue on additional pages if you need to.

Your statement for additional care settings

During the night was often the worst. Staff would come into our rooms and kick us as a form of punishment. We never felt safe, even in bed. Instead of being protected, we lived in fear of staff coming into our rooms and physically assaulting us. I remember being kicked about on numerous occasions, and the fear of what might happen at night has stayed with me ever since.
