## Chronology qualifications

- Paper records use 10/02/2000 as Kibble admission, while the database/IEP use 16/02/2000 for Clyde View. The records themselves show an initial South/Mossedge phase before transfer to Clydeview on 16/02, which may account for the difference.
- The database release date of 15/06/2000 and Mossway 13-15/06/2000 overlap with paper records showing Extended Day transition around 07-08/06. The overlap is preserved rather than reconciled by assumption.
- Ballikinrain is evidenced as an assessment/short-term location in early January 2001, but the records say it could not provide a long-term placement. St John's is confirmed as a later placement only by a July 2001 contact note.
- Extended Day/COSS was a day-support arrangement rather than evidence of overnight residence. It is included because it forms the transition/aftercare chronology and is important to interpreting the residential release dates.
