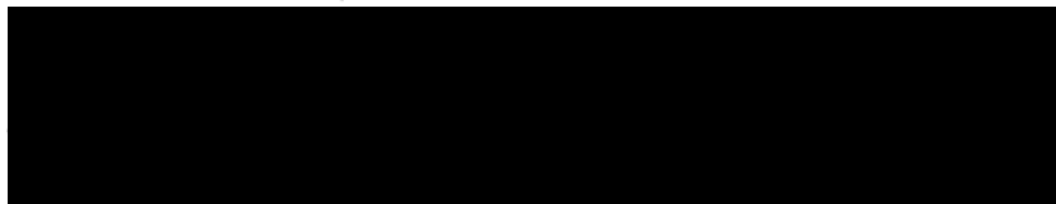

Initially it was difficult to engage him because he was so tense and uncommunicative. He was clear that he would not have attended if it had not been for his partner's prompting. As the appointment unfolded, his rapport improved and he was able to describe depressive symptoms throughout most of his adult life which he related to his adverse experiences when growing up. He described being given up at 3 weeks old by his mother who was only 16 at the time and subsequently spending his upbringing in care. He said that he did not settle in various foster families and eventually lived in about 4 different places, ultimately in Barrhead.

He then let me know that in his early twenties he traced his mother, who lived in Dundee. He hoped at that time to reconcile things with her and, although giving the impression of getting
