Q4 | On the next page, please provide as much information as you can about:

- the abuse you experienced while living in this care setting
- what life was like for you during this time
- how the people responsible for your care and welfare failed to carry out that duty (within or beyond your care setting)

You can continue on additional pages if you need to.

Your statement for additional care settings

Whilst I was there, there was the occasional slap if we spoke back to staff, which was unacceptable. We were treated like adult criminals rather than children who needed care and support. It felt as though the staff did not care about our welfare or wellbeing. However, it was nothing like what I experienced at Kerelaw. The level of violence and abuse there was far more severe and happened much more regularly.
