Collected Leon from his house to take him to St Andrews Community Hospital for his dermatology outpatient appointment with Dr Daikin. After sitting down in the waiting room, Leon was told that Dr Daikin was running 30 minutes behind schedule. This created a lot of anxiety for Leon which resulted in him becoming very restless and wanting to reschedule the appointment as he felt this was too long to wait. After reassurance, Leon agreed to wait to be seen. Leon engaged well in conversation whilst in the waiting room and this helped distract Leon from his anxiety of waiting. When seen by Dr Daikin she advised Leon that he needs to use Fucibet cream on his skin twice daily as his skin is looking very red at present. She discussed with Leon the option of light therapy and Leon was keen to go ahead with this. Dr Daikin reminded Leon that once he starts the light therapy it is very important that he is consistent with attending 3 times per week as at each session the strength is increased, so if Leon was to miss a couple of sessions then they would need to go back to the start again with the lowered strength. The waiting time for light therapy is usually 4-6 weeks by Dr Daikin is going to put the referral through as urgent and someone will be in contact with Leon soon. Leon happy with the outcome of this. Request put in to GP for repeat prescription of fucibet cream. Leon has a clinic appointment at 3pm on 25/01/17 which CPN and student nurse will facilitate.

His cpn has been taking him to these appointments as he would be unable to attend on his own due to his psychosis and extreme anxiety and fear of going outside . Unfortunately as the time in the cubical increases he is becoming more anxious and on todays session he only managed 15 seconds instead of the 57 seconds he was to have . Each day the time increases by around 15 seconds which is something in his present state he is not able to cope with. Discussed with his key worker Trixi Heather today asking if she could speak to Dr Olley about the problem and ask if he would prescribe Diazepam 5mg to be taken an hour prior to treatment to help with his anxiety state . Also asked him to take some music to listen to while in the cubical .His mother has been in contact she is arranging for his bathroom to be decorated and a shower to be fitted in an attempt to promote better hygiene and more frequent washing to help with his psoriasis .Leon had no money at the end of last week this was because a former patient (Mr S Anderson) who lives close by has been borrowing money from him . Cpn is not keen for Leon to continue this friendship due to the other persons alcohol and drug taking activities, it appears leon is afraid of this man .Plan to continue visits on a Monday Wednesday Friday to take him to St Andrews hospital

Progress since last review

Leon continues to attend his appointments within Weston House for Clozapine monitoring and to collect his medication.

Leon has kept his regular engagement with CMHN appointments and has been working on identified goals. The frequency of contact at present is 4-6 weekly, face to face or via telephone contact.

Receives an hour of support on a daily basis from Richmond Fellowship.

Leon continues to maintain regular contact with his befriender.

Since last review Leon has had input from OT services, he was discharged from this in April due to a lack of engagement in the work required to move towards his goal of using public transport.

Issues arising/ Areas of concern

Ongoing issue remains that Leon is rarely leaving his house due to poor motivation, anxiety and physical health issues. He will only do so if getting in to someone's car or a taxi, which is very limiting for him. Discharged from OT in April due to lack of readiness to progress towards his goal. Leon could be referred back to this service in the future but needs to display positive changes and a readiness to engage in active work.

Leon is supported by Richmond staff, but there are ongoing concerns around motivating Leon to take more responsibility for his domestic chores. OT Shona McInnes has offered to do a supportive session for Richmond staff to develop strategies and skills in this area.

Ongoing issue remains that the allocation of hours for Leon from Richmond (one hour a day) are limiting in regards to supporting him with socialisation. Leon maintains that despite his difficulties he wants to be able to get out of the house more. Graham Lumsden has said there is scope to adjust the hours when necessary to allow for this.

CMHN and Leon will explore anxiety management strategies in order to work towards his goal of getting out of the house more.

Discussions had around a recent incident whereby Leon spent £1,300 in a day when money that he did not have had accidentally become available to him due to a bank error. This money has had to be repaid to the bank from Leon's trust account, which now has severely depleted funds available to him. Leon continues to have difficulty managing his own finances and continues to be fully supported with this by Richmond.

Progress since last review

Leon continues to attend his appointments within Weston House for Clozapine monitoring and to collect his medication.

Leon has kept his regular engagement with CMHN appointments and has been working on identified goals with CMHN Brougham. Some progress has been made in regards to Leon going fishing, twice with staff and once on his own but with support with transport. The hope is that there will be further opportunities for this with support from Richmond. It has been suggested that Leon use his own money for paying for a taxi to/from fishing lake.

Leon continues to receive an hour of support on a daily basis from Richmond Fellowship. Leon reports that he is trying hard to keep on top of housework with support.

Leon remains on the waiting list for a befriender through Crossroads, he has recently made enquiries to confirm this.

Issues arising/ Areas of concern

Ongoing issue remains that Leon is rarely leaving his house due to low motivation, anxiety and physical health issues. He will only do so by car or a taxi, which is very limiting for him. Reports that he has not been out at all over the summer. (Apart from a couple of trips to Burger King with Richmond Staff).

Discharged from OT in April 2024 due to lack of readiness to progress towards his goal. Leon could be referred back to this service in the future but needs to display positive changes and a readiness to engage in active work.

Leon does identify this as a goal of his and CMHN Brougham is now involved and will be taking forward some graded exposure type work to improve this situation. This work has been on hold recently due to staff absence. Discussion's had about ongoing poor condition of Leon's tenancy, and how this poses environmental risks. Previous CPA review highlighted need for a deep clean, which SW Michael Ireland had agreed to look in to. There has been no feedback regarding this and as SW not present at this review CMHN will make contact to follow this up.
