27 February 2020 – Part 1, PDF page 263

A healthcare record states that:

- Her father was an alcoholic.
 - He sexually and physically abused her.
 - She went into care.
 - She moved from Scotland.
 - She became involved with the “wrong crowd”.
 - She subsequently ended up in Borstal.
 - She had never dealt with her mental-health and anger issues.
 - She felt emotionally numb and unemotional.
 - She drank alcohol “to forget”.
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- Recurrent diagnoses or recorded problems of **depression** and **anxiety with depression**.
 - Low mood.
 - Anger issues that she said had never been dealt with.
 - Emotional numbness and feeling unemotional.
 - Poor sleep and longstanding insomnia.
 - Poor appetite and weight loss during periods of mental ill-health.
 - Social withdrawal and anxiety about leaving home.
 - Occasional or longstanding suicidal thoughts.
 - Crisis-team information being provided.
 - Referral to community mental-health services.
 - Attendance or correspondence from a mental-health clinic.
 - Treatment with antidepressant medication.
 - Difficulty maintaining composure while discussing abuse and lack of support.
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7 October 2019 – Part 1, PDF page 73: low mood and longstanding occasional suicidal thoughts; request for counselling; community mental-health referral.

30 September 2019 – Part 1, PDF page 74: anxiety with depression, poor sleep, poor appetite and weight loss.

January 2025 – Part 1, PDF pages 22–23: continuing anxiety, reluctance or inability to go out, poor sleep, low mood and limited support.

29 May 2025 – Part 1, PDF page 20: depression remained inadequately controlled; mood fluctuated; she reported that suicidal thoughts could occur when she was particularly low.

27 February 2020 – Part 1, PDF page 263: emotional numbness, anger issues and drinking to forget, explicitly placed alongside the childhood-abuse history

30 September 2019 – Part 1, PDF page 74: not fit for work due to anxiety with depression.

28 October and 29 November 2019 – Part 1, PDF page 73: further fit notes for anxiety with depression.

10 March 2025 – Part 1, PDF page 22: chronically unemployed.

Sertraline for depression and anxiety.

Mirtazapine for depression, sleep and appetite-related symptoms.

Amitriptyline, recorded as being taken for depression and pain and prescribed at night.

Thiamine and folic acid, consistent with management of risks associated with harmful alcohol use.

Historical short-term sleeping medication, including zopiclone and diazepam.
