Q1 | What is the name or location of the relevant care setting you were abused in?

- what life was like for you during this time
- how the people responsible for your care and welfare failed to carry out that duty (within or beyond your care setting)

Your statement for additional care settings

I was a young boy when I was place here.

When I first got there it was intimidating, they'd ask me things I didn't like.

I was made to go down on my hands and knee's and forced to eat food I didn't like. The nuns would stand on the back of my head and make me eat the food I didn't like. They were never interested in how many times we'd throw up.

I was also told that I wasn't "wanted" and "my parents don't like me" and was worn at. I also experienced another older girl get naked and made me touch her in places I didn't know anything about and this was unacceptable with me being so young and being taken advantage of.

I was also made to touch myself whilst the nuns watched.
