

Evidence Review - Ref 100403

Scottish Redress evidence extraction and page-reference schedule

This review identifies the strongest placement, legal-status, care-history and impact material in the supplied bundles. The records are predominantly scanned historic documents, with some handwriting and redactions. No clear direct allegation of physical or sexual abuse was identified in the strongest legible records reviewed; this should not be treated as proof that no abuse occurred. Any unclear handwritten material should be checked against the original image before quoting verbatim.

2. Abuse / neglect / disclosure findings

Physical abuse: No clear direct account of being hit, punched, kicked, slapped, beaten, restrained, force-fed, exposed to cold bathing, or injured by staff was identified in the strongest legible records reviewed.

Sexual abuse: No clear direct sexual-abuse allegation concerning Andrew was identified in the strongest legible records reviewed. One 1983 review contains safeguarding language concerning a perceived "moral danger" in the mother's home relating to another child; this is not evidence of sexual abuse of Andrew and should not be presented as such.

Emotional / psychological impact: Records describe Andrew as "deep and anxious" after the January 1982 admission, repeatedly anxious about his mother, later very anxious about parental-rights action, with deteriorating school work, regressed attitude and being a "loner" (Reports 1983 p.13).

Neglect: The reviewed records mainly concern instability in the family home rather than neglect within the care establishments. Ann Street is repeatedly described as providing stability, with school improvement and good health.

Disclosures / institutional failure: No clear contemporaneous disclosure by Andrew of abuse by residential staff, and no clear record of staff disciplinary action, police investigation, or repeated complaints against care staff, was identified in the strongest legible records reviewed.
