We had a CPA meeting at the Weston day hospital during the summer when I had seen him then - at that point he was functioning reasonably well though understandably still in the process of adjusting to life without his mother who had died earlier this year.

Due to his non attendance, he will be offered another appointment at my clinic in the coming weeks.

**I advised his GP re his latest blood tests checked at the Weston day hospital on 11.10.22 - these were normal except for:**

- ALT (slightly elevated at 61)
- CRP (slightly raised at 9.1) - improved
- WCC (slightly raised at 10.6) - improved from 15.9 in September 2022

with CMHN Melville due to  
complaints of an increase in

amount, advising me that he has

publication of a book. Leon was  
pleased with his purchases and  
felt that this was a good use of his  
money.

During our visit we discussed  
Leon's current nursing care plan  
and Leon has signed this.

I explained to Leon that there were  
changes to how medication would  
be getting dispensed and only  
Clozapine medication would be  
issued from Weston in the near  
future, with the rest being issued  
by GP practice. Initially Leon has  
reservations but was agreeable to  
this change with support from  
CMHN. No date has been set yet  
for this change happening.

No new concerns were raised by

I saw Leon at home for a planned appointment today.

Leon presented as bright in mood and engaged well with myself. He was pleased to tell me that he had been out for a couple of short walks with his support worker, he hopes to continue this. He intends on going to the Bothy this week, although did report feeling an increase in anxiety last time he was there. We spent time discussing how we can tackle these symptoms of anxiety. I suggested he refer himself to Step on Stress, online course ran by Access Therapies Fife. Leon seemed genuinely keen to try this and advised that he was able to access the internet at home. I have therefore left this with Leon to arrange. We also identified meditation/thai chi to be an effective way to promote relaxation, Leon is planning to introduce this into his regular routine.

Following the visit I have written an up to date care plan and will go through this with Leon at our next appointment and adjust it accordingly.

Yesterday (25/8/22) Leon attended Weston for his 6 monthly CPA review in the company of his Step Father George. Please see CPA care plan on forms.

During the meeting, when discussing physical health, Leon mentioned that he continues to be bothered by heartburn, despite taking regular Omeprazole to help with this. He also complained of occasional dizziness and CMHN also noted frequent raised heartrate. Dr Olley has requested that Leon's pulse be tested in his home environment to see if this makes a difference to his heartrate due to level of anxiety when attending appointments.

Much discussion took place regarding Leon's lack of motivation and his avoidance behaviour regarding leaving his house and using public transport. Leon remains on the OT waiting list and in the meantime Richmond staff and CMHN will continue to support Leon in managing his anxiety and taking gradual steps towards his goal of using the bus and attending community based groups.

Next Wednesday (31/8/22) Leon plans to attend the Sunflowers Group at Cupar YMCA in the company of his support worker Lisa. Lisa will then feedback to CMHN regarding how this went. Leon has requested that he collect his medication from Weston on Wednesday next week instead of Tuesday, as he will be in Cupar. This was agreed.

He reports that he feels his mental state is "grinding to a standstill" saying that he is tired all the time and sleeping more than usual. He described his mood as a bit depressed, which is mainly grief related. He spends a lot of his time thinking about his mum and the fact that he will never see or speak to her again, and also wondering how he will cope at times like birthdays and Christmas. He said that he has not got feelings of anger, whereas this has been something that has been a problem for him in the past. He advised me of some paranoid ideas that he has been having that people might rob him. His anxiety levels continue to be problematic, especially at night time. He continues to avoid going out because of this, but does manage his fortnightly outings to the Bothy.

Leon advised me that he has not heard from his son Darren for a number of weeks now which is concerning him and he has intrusive thoughts about Darren harming himself. He has regular contact with step father George who plans to attend Leon's CPA with him next week.

We explored how Leon has been in regards working towards identified goals from previous visit. Leon advised that he has not been leaving the house for short walks and has not yet made attempts to use buses to get around. I encouraged him to try this with his support workers, even if only for a very short journey, Leon stated that he would endeavour to do this. I also encouraged him to

I attended Leon at home for a scheduled appointment. My visit had woken Leon up, despite having phoned him prior to leaving Weston. I suggested re-scheduling but Leon said that wasn't necessary. He told me he is not a morning person, so I will aim to give afternoon appointments in future.

We discussed the fact that Leon's gym sessions with Steve have stopped now due to difficulties that Leon was having engaging with same. He identified a combination of anxiety and the grieving process as the reasons for this. Leon has contacted Senga from LINK befriending who has advised Leon that she is still in the process of finding a suitable replacement for Leon's last befriender who has now left.

Leon engaged in conversation with me about his anxiety. He was unable to identify what the cause of it has been but did tell me that he never used to feel like this. We spent time exploring how this is impacting on his daily life and what his goals would be for the future. He identified the following goals:

1. Would like to be able to use buses independently to travel to Cupar/Glenrothes/St Andrews;
2. Be able to go for walks;
3. Attend community based groups;
4. Get back into his writing (currently has writers block).

Leon currently feels unable to get on a bus on his own, he will very occasionally get a bus if in the

I visited Leon at his home today for support due to current increase in contact since the recent death of his mother.

Leon told me that he continues to struggle as a result of what happened, he knew his mum was dying but had hoped she would be here longer. I spent time listening to and supporting Leon. We then engaged in conversation about other topics, Leon spoke about wanting to reconnect with old friends from his 20s who he had lost contact with due to his ex partner Liz coming between them. He thinks he might make contact with them via Facebook.

Leon is due to come into Weston tomorrow for clozapine bloods and fasting blood glucose. He voiced that he would like to try a different medication some time as he doesn't like having to attend for bloods every 4 weeks, he said "being like a human pin cushion". He also described feeling over sedated due to clozapine. Saying he feels groggy in the morning and will sometimes take day time naps and then not be able to sleep well at night as a result. We discussed how his mental state is stable at present and due to current stressors it may not be the best time to consider medication changes, Leon was agreeable to this at this moment in time.

We discussed Leon's main problem at the moment is independently utilising public transport and getting out and about. This is something that he wants to improve and remains on the waiting list for OT input.

Leon informed me about his mother, condolences given to Leon at this difficult time. When asked how he was doing Leon answered "ok" but has been sleeping a lot more than normal. Instructor explained to Leon he will have his grieving process to go through but would love to see him continuing to be mindful of healthier choices regarding both physical activity and nutritional intake. Leon reports he has been out on a few occasions with care staff for very short walks and has also reduced the packets of biscuits he is buying from 5/6 packets to 1/2, encouraged Leon to continue with his more positive choice making and continue to attempt to get out and move more, particularly if he wishes to make his goal of weight loss. Leon phoned this morning requesting to speak with myself. He was feeling anxious and panicky. He told me that his Richmond worker did not visit as planned yesterday, due to staff sickness. He also said that his mum is not well and described her as being "in a really bad way". He also learned last week that he will no longer be having contact with his befriender Neil, and as a result Leon feels that he "has had the rug pulled out from under him". LINK befriending are apparently going to look into matching Leon up with an alternative person to take over the befriender role. He identified his main concern at the moment was worries about his mother.

I spent time offering reassurance and chatting with Leon, I acknowledged all of his worries and how they are impacting on him presently. We explored the resources that Leon has that are helping him, including his gym sessions with Steve, his visits to the music sessions at the Bothy and his regular contact with Richmond staff as well as his many hobbies. He shared with me that he has just received a new base guitar that his mother had ordered for him sometime ago.

Leon was more relaxed following our conversation and will be attending the clozapine clinic tomorrow for his medication.

Leon reports that he is getting on ok but does continue to experience a depressed mood. He identified the main cause of this being loneliness. He also worries about his mother and how he is going to cope "when the time comes" and she passes away. Reassurance and support offered in regards to this.

We discussed building structure to his week and I praised Leon for the efforts he is making with attending the gym and the Bothy, which he intends to go to this evening. He has not yet started going out for short walks yet and I encouraged him to do this as it can help improve his mood. His befriender, Neil, is back after a period of absence and they have fortnightly contact which Leon enjoys. Leon continues to have daily input from Richmond for an hour in the morning. I suggested the Sunflowers support group that is on on a Friday morning at YMCA might be an option that would suit Leon, he advised that this and Neil might be too much in one day though, perhaps Leon could attend this on a fortnightly basis? We will discuss further at next appointment. I also suggested Weston gardening group, Leon declined this saying that he has no interest in gardening.

Leon continues to engage well in his hobbies when at home, he spends an hour a day playing his musical instruments/singing and has also been working on a novel and painting his figures.

Despite problems with anxiety which have been longstanding he was still in regular contact with his befriender who he sees regularly. He continues to enjoy hobbies, which includes playing his guitar and there was not evidence of Depressive symptoms that day. He denied suicidal ideation or plans, appetite was intact and he had slept well the night before. He did not report paranoid ideation, which had been prominent in the past when unwell.

He denied auditory hallucinations however did report recently when looking at photos not recognizing the faces of people in them despite knowing them well, which he had found upsetting at the time. He did not describe any other possible psychotic symptoms that day

Leon shared his frustrations that Senior support worker Graham Lumsden is "dragging his heels" about a request Leon has made for money recently and this is stressing him out. I enquired if he was referring to the request of £2,750 for a new guitar that we spoke about at our last appointment and Leon said it was. Through discussion Leon acknowledged that this is a particularly large amount of money and that this is why it was taking a while for Graham to process this request. Leon does recognise that he has a tendency to over spend his money which is why Richmond support him with budgeting.

Leon also shared that his son had contacted him to inform him that Darren's mum (Leon's ex) has undergone surgery to have part of her lung removed. This has impacted on Leon in that he has been worrying about his son going through a difficult time with his mum. CMHN validated his concerns and offered support and reassurance.

He shared that he is feeling overly tired, sleeping well overnight but also napping alot during the day too, also he is experiencing a flare up with his eczema.

On a more positive note Leon's next book is due to be published on his birthday 17/3/26. And he spoke about hoping to go for a meal at the newly opened pub around the corner from him.

Leon's mental state remains fairly  
stable at present. He does report  
occasional panic attacks and  
ongoing grief following mothers  
death. He copes with this by  
playing his guitars, he has not  
made it to The Bothy for the past  
month saying that he is too tired,  
and the weather and darker nights  
are not helping, he does plan to  
return though. He recently spoke  
with Senga from LINK befriending,  
there are as yet no suitable  
matches for Leon. We discussed  
other community resources that  
might help connect Leon with other  
people, St/N Donaldson will  
explore whether Castle furniture  
project still provide a befriending  
service. I advised Leon that I could  
accompany him to a group for his  
first visit, eg, the Sunflowers Group  
in Cupar, Leon seemed open to  
this idea.

Leon complained of physical  
problems, including a cough that  
can sometimes cause him to be  
breathless during the night, he  
says he has had this on and off  
since last Christmas. I encouraged  
Leon to contact his GP about this.  
He also complained of sore skin  
on his feet, making it  
uncomfortable when he's walking.  
He plans to contact the skin clinic  
for support with this.

Leon was visited by his son Darren  
and step dad George last week  
and they put some shelves up for  
him. He is unsure what his plans  
are over Christmas yet but will  
likely stay at home, but he will get  
a support worker for an hour a half  
as it is a Sunday.

Leon presented as bright in mood  
and engaged well with myself. He  
was pleased to tell me that he had  
been out for a couple of short  
walks with his support worker, he  
hopes to continue this. He intends  
on going to the Bothy this week,  
although did report feeling an  
increase in anxiety last time he  
was there. We spent time  
discussing how we can tackle  
these symptoms of anxiety. I  
suggested he refer himself to Step  
on Stress, online course ran by  
Access Therapies Fife. Leon  
seemed genuinely keen to try this  
and advised that he was able to  
access the internet at home. I  
have therefore left this with Leon  
to arrange. We also identified  
meditation/thai chi to be an  
effective way to promote

During the meeting, when discussing physical health, Leon mentioned that he continues to be bothered by heartburn, despite taking regular Omeprazole to help with this. He also complained of occasional dizziness and CMHN also noted frequent raised heartrate. Dr Olley has requested that Leon's pulse be tested in his home environment to see if this makes a difference to his heartrate due to level of anxiety when attending appointments.

Much discussion took place regarding Leon's lack of motivation and his avoidance behaviour regarding leaving his house and using public transport. Leon remains on the OT waiting list and in the meantime Richmond staff and CMHN will continue to support Leon in managing his anxiety and taking gradual steps towards his goal of using the bus and attending community based groups.

Next Wednesday (31/8/22) Leon plans to attend the Sunflowers Group at Cupar YMCA in the company of his support worker Lisa. Lisa will then feedback to CMHN regarding how this went. Leon has requested that he collect his medication from Weston on Wednesday next week instead of Tuesday, as he will be in Cupar. This was agreed.

He reports that he feels his mental state is "grinding to a standstill" saying that he is tired all the time and sleeping more than usual. He described his mood as a bit depressed, which is mainly grief related. He spends a lot of his time thinking about his mum and the fact that he will never see or speak to her again, and also wondering how he will cope at times like birthdays and Christmas. He said that he has not got feelings of anger, whereas this has been something that has been a problem for him in the past. He advised me of some paranoid ideas that he has been having that people might rob him. His anxiety levels continue to be problematic, especially at night time. He continues to avoid going out because of this, but does manage his fortnightly outings to the Bothy.

Leon advised me that he has not heard from his son Darren for a number of weeks now which is concerning him and he has intrusive thoughts about Darren harming himself. He has regular contact with step father George who plans to attend Leon's CPA with him next week.

We explored how Leon has been in regards working towards identified goals from previous visit. Leon advised that he has not been leaving the house for short walks and has not yet made attempts to use buses to get around. I encouraged him to try this with his support workers, even if only for a very short journey, Leon stated that he would endeavour to do this. I also encouraged him to
