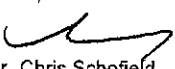

Diagnosis: COVID-19 pneumonitis
Follow-up: None

William Tarbett was admitted to the Covid assessment unit on 08/07/21 with worsening breathlessness, a dry cough and chest pain having tested positive for COVID-19 on 25/06/21. He required 60% of oxygen support on admission, and a CXR showed changes consistent with Covid pneumonitis. The rest of his blood tests including a D-dimer were of nil concern. He was commenced on dexamethasone as an inpatient, and his insulin regime was adjusted accordingly.

He has recovered well on the ward and has now been weaned off oxygen. We have stopped his dexamethasone and he is back on his usual insulin regime, with advice to keep a close and regular eye on his blood sugars. As he is keen for home and looks quite well, the team are happy to discharge him home. He has been given worsening advice and knows to seek urgent medical help if he feels more unwell at any point. He has also been given an oxygen saturations probe and will be contacted daily by the team for a week to monitor his recovery.

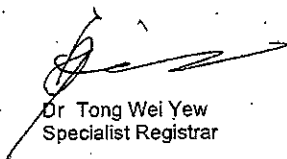

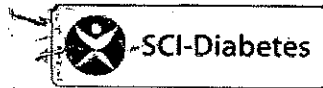

Summary:

I reviewed William in the Diabetes Clinic today. He has been recently diagnosed with diabetes when he presented with balanitis whereby his random fasting glucose was 19.2 and a repeat fasting was 16.1 with an HbA1c of 115 mmol/mol in August 2014. He did not experience any weight loss or polydipsia, but did complain of some amount of polyuria over the past few months. He is obese with a BMI of 36.4. There is a family history of Type 2 Diabetes and his anti GAD and Ia2 antibodies were all negative. He does not appear to be cushingoid or acromegalic and is not taking any steroids that could lead to hyperglycaemia. Taking into account these clinical features he most likely has Type 2 Diabetes. His HbA1c repeated today is 120 mmol/mol and I have arranged for him to see the Dietitian for dietary advice, general diabetes advice and self monitoring on glucose after a session with the Diabetes Specialist Nurses. I have suggested we increase his Gliclazide to 80mgs twice a day and add on Metformin 500mgs twice a day and if he tolerates this without any significant side effects we can increase this further to 1g twice a day.

We will review him again in 6 weeks time and if his glycaemic control is still unsatisfactory we may need to add insulin therapy.

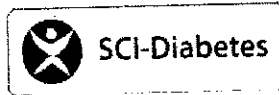

Summary:

Thank you for your further letter regarding this gentleman who was diagnosed with type 2 diabetes last year. He has a family history of type 2 also affecting his father at a young age. He as you mentioned failed to attend offered follow up appointments and glycaemic control remains very poor with an HbA1c of 127 mmol/mol. He is currently on Gliclazide 80 mg bd along with a combination tablet of Metformin and Saxagliptin. He currently takes his medication with his breakfast but then second dose prior to bed. I initially suggested he brings this forward to being in combination with his evening meal. His wife supports him with his medication, I believe with a pill box. He is not currently working and they have a new baby of 2 weeks old so he is out walking more but does no other formal activity. He has seen the Dietitian on one occasion and did not wish further dietetic input today.

He is thirsty but feels there has actually been a reduction in his thirst and polyuria since his diagnosis last year and he has certainly cut back on fizzy drinks but did not feel there was other particular dietary change to make.

I would agree that he is progressing to injectable therapy and we discussed both GLP-1 agonist therapy and insulin today and on balance will initiate insulin given his current level of glycaemic control but may progress to adding in GLP agonists with a view to transition thereafter. He is needle phobic and is uncertain whether he will manage to self-administer. He met with one of the Nurse Specialists this afternoon for demonstration of an insulin pen to see how he feels he would cope with this. He has an early follow up with the Nurse Specialists and a formal Nurse Led Clinic review in 2 months' time and General Clinic review in 4.

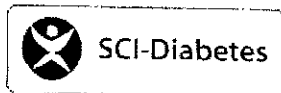

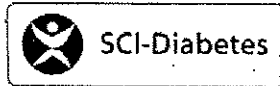

This gentleman attended for review today having missed his last appointment.

He is now on Humulin I, 36 units once daily and his Gliclazide was stopped, I think in the surgery not long after initiating this. He continues on Metformin in addition. HbA1c remains poor, but has improved from 123 to 84 mmol/mol and he has been doing some insulin dose adjustment. However, monitored blood glucose levels remain high generally 10-14 fasting and mid to high teens by late afternoon.

He is not currently working, but is optimistic that he will have a job as a steward at the Ice Arena in the near future. He is a non driver. He has a young daughter and he does go out for walks regularly with her.

His osmotic symptoms are improving, though he remains tired particularly late afternoon.

We will arrange Dietetic review for him and he also missed his last offered eye screening appointment and it is possible we will get this done today in addition.

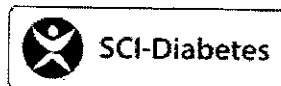

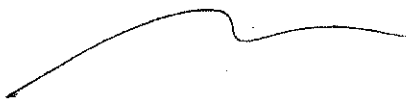
I have checked through his notes again and there is no evidence of him attending the surgery on the 23rd June 2011 for a rash either in the computer notes or in the practice appointment system.

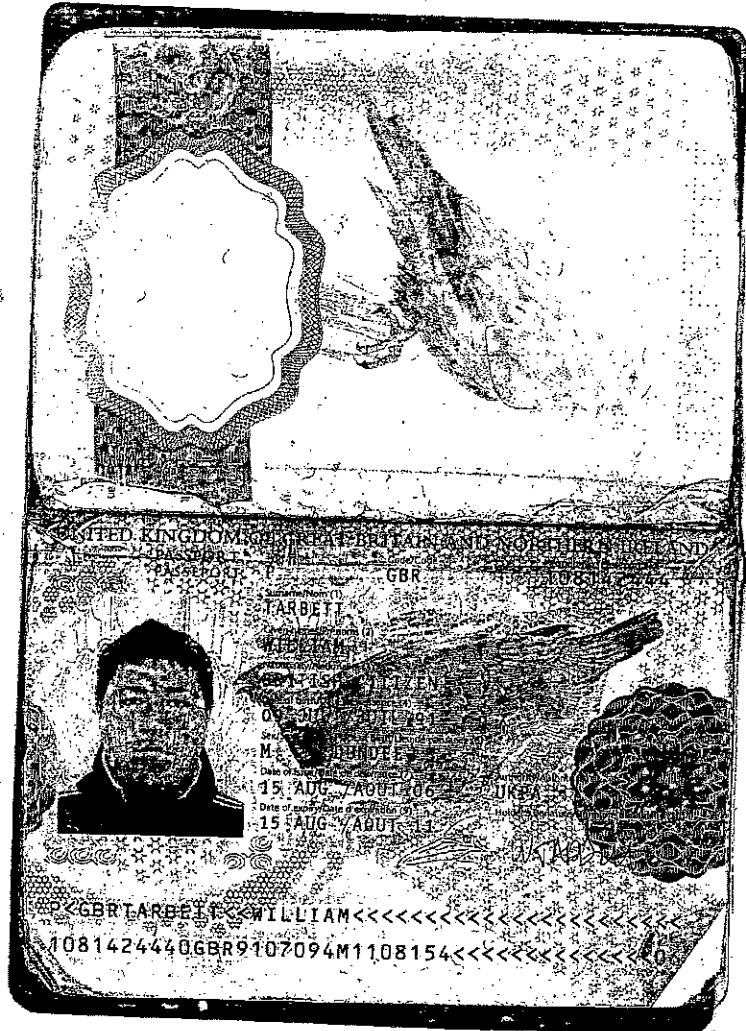

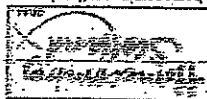
