Update Medical Report on William Tarbett (09.07.91)

He has been referred to Educational Psychology (in P1) and was observed in class at St Clements. Formal Education Psychology involvement was not recommended following this. Recent discussions have again suggested that an Educational Psychology assessment may be helpful in updating the comprehensive assessment of William, prior to the Social Work Department making new plans for him.

Health

William had one chesty cough last winter, requiring a reliever inhaler, but has had no other evidence of asthma in this placement. He has no cough or wheeze at night, on exercise or with colds.

He may still be susceptible to asthma with bad colds/flu. He has had no other health problems recently.

He has had his hearing checked 3 times since his permanence medical, once at the Hearing Clinic. It has been normal on all occasions.

His eyesight was tested and found to be normal on 17.09.98. He received his Pre-School booster on 23.08.96.

On Examination

William was a sturdy, friendly boy who was generally restless, flitting between activities.

He is right handed, left footed, with left eye dominant.

His pencil skills are poor, with poor pencil control and immature content of his drawing, as well as immature execution (score 6.5 years at 7 years 5 months). He made a willing attempt to spell his name but the writing was large, irregular, poorly formed and spelt "wililm tarbitt".

His gross motor skills are fair, hopping well on either foot, although he could not hop on the spot.

Tone and reflexes appeared normal.

Examination of William's ears, throat, cardiovascular and respiratory systems revealed no abnormality. His abdomen was normal, testes both descended, pre-pubertal. He still has all his first teeth, in good condition.

William volunteered information and spoke coherently.

Following your appointment on 14th August 2018 with diarrhoea and vomiting, I notice that your blood results from then showed a very high level of glucose. The test reports a 3 month overview of your glucose control and this is currently standing at 121. Ideally we would like that figure to be nearer 54. I notice from our discussion that you don't currently take your diabetic medication and have not been seen in clinic. I also noticed that you didn't turn up for diabetic review yesterday. My concern with your glucose control being so high is that you will feel unwell but more than that the long term consequences of uncontrolled high sugars is that of damage to the eye sight, damage to the kidneys and damage to your circulation putting you at increased risk of a stroke or a heart attack. I appreciate having a diagnosis can be very alarming, however, we have a lot of support to help you through this and controlling your blood sugars. I would be very grateful if you could come in and see Jackie, our diabetic specialist nurse, or you can use the drop in service at Ninewells Diabetic Centre on Level 7, which is on a Wednesday morning. There is a team of diabetic specialist nurses who are very used to helping people with their uncontrolled sugars. If you have any concerns or questions you would like to discuss in person, please don't hesitate to make an appointment with myself or Dr Dorward, our diabetic specialist.

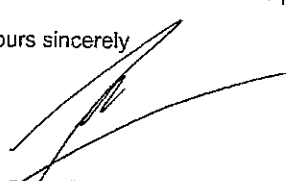
