There is a leaflet with this letter which will tell you about the hearing.

You may want to tell the hearing what you think would be best for you. You have the right to do that. If you do want to, you can tell me before the hearing starts or you can say it at the hearing.

You can write to me if you want. Whatever you tell me or write to me will be passed on to the panel members and also to your parents or main carers and to the safeguarder if one is appointed by the hearing. **You can either write to me on the page which is attached, or on another piece of paper.**

If you want to, you can bring someone with you to the hearing, a representative, to help you talk to the panel members. Travel expenses will be paid to you and your representative.

The children's reporter has arranged for

The reason for this is:

The child has committed an offence, this being grounds in terms of Section 52(2)I) of the Children (Scotland) Act 1995

Statement of Facts

In support of the above it is stated:

1. That he did, on 26th December 1999, in Royal Street, Gourock, attempt to force open lockfast motor vehicle, registered number J688 GGB, with intent to steal therefrom.
NATURE OF OFFENCE: ATTEMPTED OPENING LOCKFAST PLACES WITH INTENT TO STEAL.

2. That he did, on 26th December 1999, within a marked police vehicle then parked in Royal Street, Gourock, obstruct Grant MacLeod and Kenneth Gilkison, both Constables of Strathclyde Police then in uniform and whilst engaged in the lawful execution of their duty by attempting to conceal a small plastic pipe and cigarette lighter within the rear of said police vehicle and thereafter struggle with said officers.
NATURE OF OFFENCE: CONTRARY TO THE POLICE (SCOTLAND) ACT 1967 SECTION 41(1)(A).

3. That he did, on 26th December 1999, within a marked police vehicle then travelling in Eldon St., Greenock, assault Grant MacLeod a Constable of Strathclyde Police then in uniform and engaged in the lawful execution of his duty by striking him on the face with his arm.
NATURE OF OFFENCE: CONTRARY TO THE POLICE (SCOTLAND) 41(1)(A)

4. That he did, on 15th February 2000, within the South Unit, Kibble School, Goudie St., Paisley, assault Samuel Ros, aged 45, c/o Reporter's Office, 1/3 Brisbane St., Greenock, and did strike him on his head with his fist.
NATURE OF OFFENCE: ASSAULT.

5. That he did, on 15th February 2000, within the South Unit, Kibble School, Goudie St., Paisley, conduct himself in a disorderly manner and commit a breach of the peace.
NATURE OF OFFENCE: BREACH OF THE PEACE.

6. That he did, on 15th February 2000, within the South Unit, Kibble School, Goudie St., Paisley, assault [REDACTED] and punch and kick him on his head and body to his injury.
NATURE OF OFFENCE: ASSAULT.

7. That he did, on 15th February 2000, within the South Unit, Kibble School, Goudie St., Paisley, assault Stephen McKeown, and punch him.
NATURE OF OFFENCE: ASSAULT.

If any of the reasons are not accepted, the hearing may either discharge them or tell the reporter to apply to the sheriff who will decide if any of the reasons are proved.

If the sheriff decides that any of the reasons are proved, the children's hearing will then discuss what is best for the child, as if these reasons had been accepted. If the sheriff decides that no reasons are proved the case will be discharged.
