Points from Discussion

- Kevin is previously known to INFORM.
- It is reported that Kevin's residential day placement has broken down following an assault on a teacher this being the third incident of assault on member of staff. Kibble School have permanently excluded Kevin from their education provision.
- Kevin's attitude has deteriorated at home. He is outwith control and acts on impulse. Kevin has been reported missing on several occasions. Various strategies have been employed with Kevin and failed. Kevin offers no explanation for his behaviour and is uncommunicative. Kevin has been involved in another recent car theft and he was driving under the influence of alcohol at high speed.
- Kevin's parents remain supportive of him but are at a loss to understand Kevin's offending behaviour. They feel that a Residential School Placement is necessary.
- After the recent incident at Kibble School it is alleged that Kevin advised a pupil of a sexually related childhood experience. This has since been denied by Kevin. The alleged incident has been discussed with his parents. It was agreed that fuller clarification should be sought.

- The meeting agreed that Kevin's behaviour and aggressive outbursts directed at male authority figures is extremely concerning and an investigation/assessment should be undertaken to find out what triggers his violent behaviour. All were in agreement that a Day Placement would not be suitable to address Kevin's needs and a Residential Placement would be more appropriate.
