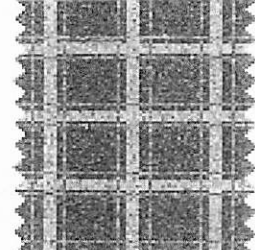

PROGRESS IN CLYDEVIEW UNIT

Since Kevin's admission to Clydeview he has posed little or no management problems. He interacts well with both peers and staff and can easily engage with staff in topics of his own choosing.

HOME LEAVE PROGRAMME/FAMILY CONTACT

Kevin has enjoyed a regular pattern of leave at weekends (Friday - Monday) and one mid-week, Tuesday nights. This pattern broke down for a period of two weeks due to Kevin absconding and being missing for a short period. Mr & Mrs McGowan both worked very closely with writer in getting Kevin's leave back on track quickly.

AREAS OF STRENGTH

1. Kevin's personality allows him to mix well with others.
2. Kevin's attendance at education.
3. Kevin's commitment to rebuild his relationship with his parents.

AREAS OF CONCERN

1. Kevin's recent period of absconding.
2. His behaviour whilst missing.
3. Charges picked up whilst missing.

OUTSIDE AGENCY INVOLVEMENT (IF APPROPRIATE)

Kevin's field Social Worker Harry Scott visits Kevin at Kibble fortnightly and is in weekly contact with writer by telephone. Harry has also made home visits whilst Kevin has been on leave.

HEALTH

Kevin is a fit young man who since arriving at Kibble has had few health problems .

He has a healthy appetite enjoying regular meals including breakfast.

He takes pride in his appearance, showering/bathing daily, paying close attention to dental hygiene.

Kevin is quite an athletic young boy who enjoys most sports, especially water sports eg swimming, sailing, fishing.

INCIDENTS SINCE LAST CHILDREN'S HEARING

20/4/2000 - Kevin failed to return to Kibble at the planned time. Circulated as a missing person to Mill Street Police, Paisley. Returned to school at 10.20pm stating he had been in Gourrock with friends.

Kevin was spoken to by staff and stated that he deliberately returned late as he did not want to go to Aberdeen with his parents for Easter weekend.

21/4/2000 - Meeting held with Kevin, his parents and writer. It was agreed by all that rather than disrupt the Easter weekend further Kevin would go home and forfeit leave the following weekend for his failure to return. Kevin grounded at home by his parents.

10pm: Mrs McGowan informed staff that Kevin had left the house without permission. Advised by staff to give Kevin sometime to calm down. Reported as a missing person by mum at 11.50pm.

22/4/2000: 2am: Night care officer informed by Mrs McGowan that Kevin had returned to the house. Both parents happy to have Kevin at home O/N.

Midday: Staff contacted Mrs McGowan who stated after having given Kevin an ultimatum, remain at home or return to Kibble, Kevin had chosen to stay at home.

25/4/00: Kevin failed to return to the unit after school. Absconded in the company of another peer. Parents informed. Circulated to Mill Street Police.

26/4/00: 2am: Kevin apprehended by Police in Grangemouth in a stolen car. Charged with:

- 1) Theft of a motor vehicle.
- 2) Driving without a licence.
- 3) Driving without insurance.

Returned by Social Work Standby at 3.45am. Parents informed on his return.

27/4/00: Absconded from school in the company of another peer, parents and police informed.

9pm: sighted by other peers mother in the Lanslea area of Falkirk.

28/4/00: remains an absconder

29/4/00: remains an absconder

30/4/00: remains an absconder

1/5/00: Apprehended by police in the Bainsford area of Falkirk. Charged with (1) breaking and entering a motor vehicle (2) theft of a car radio. Picked up by staff and returned to Kibble. Parents informed.

CARE PLAN GOALS

SHORT TERM:

1. Kevin to reside in Clydeview.
2. Kevin to attend education.
3. Kevin to build a regular pattern of leave.

MEDIUM TERM

1. Kevin to work on relationship with parents.
2. Kevin to work with writer on anger management.

LONG TERM:

1. Kevin to work towards a placement within the extended day unit at Kibble.
2. Kevin to return to family home full time.

NIGHT CARE OFFICER'S REPORT

Kevin settles well at night, he presents no management problem, and is always pleasant and complying.

SUMMARY

Kevin has settled well within Clydeview unit, enjoying all aspects of the unit life. Whilst leave had had problematic areas both Kevin and his parents have worked closely with staff, resolving the problems. Kevin has attended education and appears to be applying himself to tasks set out for him.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Writer feels that today's meeting is an ideal forum to discuss all parties views in planning the way forward for Kevin within Kibble.
