STATEMENT OF FACTS

In support of Condition 1 above it is stated that:

On 9th October 1981, in the house at 91 Dunholm Road, Dundee, occupied by Priscilla Jamieson or Fraser, he did assault Brian Ewart, aged 14 years, son of and residing with [REDACTED], Dundee, bite him on the arm and strike him on the head with an ash tray. ✓

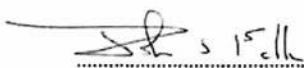
