PROBLEM: Abscondee's home address requiring to be checked out under new procedures.

ASSESSMENT/ACTION:

9.45 p.m. Phone call received from Mr Byrne, Burnside House. He advised me that Stewart Fraser and [redacted], [redacted], Dundee, had absconded from Burnside House at 7.30 p.m. this date. In accordance with the new procedures relating to absconders, could I check both home addresses, following which, if neither boy could be found, the Police would then be notified. Agreed to carry out request.

10.25 p.m. Called at 91 Dunholm Road, Dundee. Saw Mrs Fraser, a male friend and a young boy. According to Mrs Fraser, Stewart had not appeared at home - should he do so, she would advise Burnside House.

10.45 p.m. Arrived at 59 Balgowan Avenue, Dundee, where I saw both Mr and Mrs [redacted] together with other family members. They had no knowledge of [redacted] whereabouts, but should he come home, they would return him to Burnside House.

10.50 p.m. Called at Burnside House - saw Mrs Walker and Mr Miller. Neither boy had returned as yet. Stewart's Social Worker said to be Mrs Caplin, Area 1, whilst [redacted] is supervised by [redacted]. Both to be advised on 1st September, 1982.

1.9.82 7.25 a.m. Advised by Mrs Walker, Burnside House, that [redacted] and Stewart Fraser had returned (unaccompanied) to Burnside at 1.30 a.m. this date.

Early forenoon phone call made to Mrs Caplin re Stewart Fraser.

PROBLEM: Stewart well known to Loches Social Work Department

After a very fraught 4 - 6 weeks, Stewart and mother had a row and Stewart hit mother with a billiard cue (? chair). Police at house. Mother not wanting him left. He had apparently placed an axe beside chair

ASSESSMENT/ACTION:

- INFORMATION
1. Memo of July '83 on Stewart's return home from Rossie School
 2. Spoke to David Middleton; Hitting mother, Seemed a new departure, ?? glue etc. Home situation delicate and tortuous (Stewart's dad killed 2 years ago).

After seeking information discovered Police taken Stewart to Loches (Stewart seemingly not wanting to stay at home) and Mum on her way there.

At police station, heard from P.C. Waghorn of many instances involving Stewart over the last 4 - 6 weeks, many involving glue - but pointed out problems stemmed since time of Dad's death and it seems that the lad seemed absolutely disillusioned with everything.

Saw Stewart - not looking overwhelmingly keen to go home but said he would and would try and 'play' it 'cool'. Had been on glue last night - seemingly not been home till this morning when there was a row about money he stole from granny recently Otherwise gave very little away.

Spoke to Mother - still refusing to have him home - frightened following this morning and an incident a week or so ^{ago} which was the first time Stewart hit her

After much deliberation, decided on Section 15 and police took Stewart to Burnside. (I think he'd been expecting this and greeted the news a fraction more warmly than the chance of going home). Spoke to Mum in car and completed form. Mum said she'd signed a similar form on October 7th, the day after Stewart failed to appear at Panel, and the day he first hit her.

Is apparently due at Panel this Thursday, referred by Sheriff Cox following theft charges. She would not have him at home till then - and intended to ask for his removal then.

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At one stage she said he could be a very kind lad but she could no longer cope with him "cracking up" - also relating this to father's death. Work with (?) psychologist no help as couldn't understand the foreigner who saw them.

Went to Burnside - Stewart apparently relaxed and enjoying his tea. Clearly a lad carrying a fair degree of desperation. ?Likely to be "set up" by mother ??

?? Is the lad setting himself up for removal from home?

B.1. /cont'd:

He was returned to Wellington the same day. At a Hearing on 9.5.85 to give advice to Sheriff, Stewart again absconded, was apprehended by Police on 11.5.85, detained in Burnside, absconded, returned of his own volition to Wellington School 3 days later. He failed to return from leave on 17.8.85 and was not apprehended until 17.10.85.

He appeared at Dundee Sheriff court on 18.10.85 since when he has been held in perth Prison subject of an Unruly Warrant.

APPLICATION FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A CHILD IN SECURE ACCOMMODATION

Part B

Secure Unit Referrals Groups will not be prepared to consider an application that a child be detained in secure accommodation unless either

(a) he has a history of absconding and -

(1) he is likely to abscond unless he is kept in secure accommodation and

(2) if he absconds, it is likely that his physical, mental or moral welfare will be at risk or

(b) he is likely to injure himself or other persons unless he is kept in secure accommodation.

If a recommendation is being made for placement in secure accommodation of the child specified in Part A, the following information should be given:

B1. Does the child have a history of absconding from residential establishments?

Be as specific as possible on the number of incidents, particularly in the last 6 - 12 months: Stewart has absconded innumerable times from all open residential units in which he has been placed. Since his supervision requirement was varied to 44(1)(b) naming Wellington School Stewart has absconded or failed to return from leave on several occasions. Following his Hearing on 5.3.85 Stewart absconded. he was picked up by police and returned to Wellington school on 29.3.85. Following weekend leave Stewart failed to return on 9.5.85. He was picked up by police and detained in Burnside on 11.5.85. He absconded on 12.5.85. Following offences Stewart was detained by police and appeared at Sheriff court Dundee on 25.4.85. cont'd - on separate sheet

B2. Please give details of any reports dealing with the child's absconding and by whom those reports were made quoting their last known address and telephone number at which they can be contacted:

Stewart was reported by staff members of Wellington School, Penicuik, to Lothian Police and Dundee Police were notified on 28.10.85 by Social Worker, Mrs. J. Smith, Social Work Department, 74a High Street, Lochee, Dundee, and on 2 other occasions, dates not noted, to advise police of information received as to his whereabouts. Police notified by Mr. A. Nicoll, Asst. Area Fieldwork Manager, S.W.D. 74a High Street, Lochee, Dundee of Stewart's last known address on 16.10.85 or 17.10.85.

B3. If the child continues to abscond, what circumstances suggest that his 'physical, mental or moral welfare' would be at risk?

Past history has shown that when out of school Stewart commits offences, associates with adult offenders and habitually drinks intoxicating liquor. he has been known to reside with relatives known to be drug addicts and does not reside at home and is outwith the control of his parents (mother and cohabitee). it is my opinion that these circumstances constitute a physical/moral risk to Stewart.

B4. Do you consider the child to be likely to injure himself or other persons unless he is kept in secure accommodation? If YES, please give the evidence to support this assessment:

B5. Has the child ever been referred for a secure placement before?

If YES, give details:

Yes. Stewart has been in Rossie McDonald Wing on 3 previous occasions from October 1983/April 1984. Stewart was admitted to Rossie following a period when he was outwith parental control, glue sniffing, offending and absconding from home. From August - October 1984 Stewart was detained in Rossie subject to court proceedings from January/February 1985. Stewart again returned to Rossie following offences and detained until dealt with by Sheriff Court.

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- B6. In which secure unit do you wish the child to be placed?
