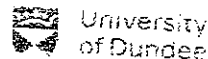

You are being invited to take part in a research study. Before you decide whether to take part, it is important for you to understand why the research is being conducted and what it will involve. Please take time to read the following information carefully before deciding whether to take part and discuss it with others if you wish. Please ask if there is anything that is not clear or if you would like more information. You will be given the duration of this visit to decide whether you would like to participate. Thank you for taking the time to read this.

About the research

Who will conduct the research?

What is the purpose of the research?

High blood pressure (also called **hypertension**) affects more than 1 in 3-4 adults worldwide. It can strain the heart and the blood vessels, and increase the risk of stroke, heart attack, heart failure, kidney damage, and death. It is a condition that is easily diagnosed and highly treatable by medications. However, up to 50% of those who are prescribed blood pressure lowering medications still have high blood pressure. This puts these patients at higher risk of strokes and heart attacks compared to those whose blood pressure is under control on treatment.

One important explanation for the poor blood pressure control in those who receive treatment for hypertension is that **patients, for many different reasons, do not take their medications as recommended**. There is very little research on how to improve blood pressure control in patients with hypertension who do not always take their medications as prescribed.

Our study will assess whether a **review of how well patients are coping with the prescribed medications can help improve blood pressure control**. Understanding the reasons for poor blood pressure control has a potential to improve the health and well-being of individual patients, avoid unnecessary tests and hospital appointments and save money in healthcare.



Why have I been chosen?

You have been invited to participate in this trial because you have high blood pressure and you are prescribed at least 2 blood pressure lowering medications.

We plan to screen approximately 2,500 patients and to recruit approximately 1,500 participants for a first visit from several specialist hypertension clinics across the United Kingdom. A total of 240 patients will be recruited for the full study.

What would my involvement be?

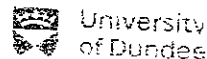
What would I be asked to do if I took part?

If you agree to participate in our study you will be required to **attend up to five visits (including this one) usually in the hospital outpatient clinic over the course of approximately 6 months**. Each visit will last roughly between thirty minutes to one hour. However, not everyone will be asked to make five visits – **some participants will be asked to attend only the first appointment**. The UOM will decide who will be invited to attend only the first or all five visits.

If you decide to take part, the treatment you receive will be identical to that received by anyone not taking part in the trial, with the addition of the trial procedures described here.

During the first visit (today) a research nurse will **explain the study** and you will have an **opportunity to ask questions**. You will have the duration of the visit to decide whether or not you would like to participate in the study. **If you are unable to decide within the time available it will not be possible for you to participate in the trial**. This will not affect your clinical care. **If you are willing to take part and if you meet the study requirements, you will be asked to sign a consent form** and you will be given a copy to take away. **The nurse will take your medical history, measure your blood pressure and ask you to provide a urine sample**. You will also be asked to **take an automatic monitor home to check your blood pressure 3 times in the morning and 3 times in the evening over a period of 7 days**. This is called 7-day home-based blood pressure monitoring. The easy-to-use equipment for measuring your blood pressure will be provided by the study team and **the research nurse will show you how to use the equipment**. This will need to be **returned back to the hospital after 7 days**. We will also ask you to **record the blood pressure readings on a diary** to avoid losing any of the readings due to faulty monitor memory or any other issues during data transfer. This will be also the final visit for some of the patients.

If you are invited to **the second visit**, you will also be invited to attend a further three visits. The second visit is planned approximately 3 weeks later and is similar to the previous visit – **the nurse will collect some necessary information about your health, blood pressure will be measured in the clinic, you will be asked to take an automatic blood pressure monitor home and a urine sample will be collected again in the clinic**.



Prior to **visit three** you will be **allocated at random to either the intervention group** where your tests and blood pressure control will be discussed between you and your doctor **or to the no-intervention groups** (sometimes called control groups) where the doctors and patients are unaware of your results and where the standard care for high blood pressure is provided. This standard care means that it will not be different to the usual care offered by a typical hypertension clinic.

You will then be followed up during **visit four** (approximately 4 months after the first visit) and **visit five** (approximately 6 months after the first) where blood pressure will be measured in the clinic, urine samples taken and 7-day home-based blood pressure monitoring requested, similar to the previous visits.

If it is not feasible to conduct all visits in the clinic, under certain circumstances and dependent on the feasibility and resources, it may be possible to conduct visits 2-5 remotely, i.e. using video links, telephone calls or home visits.

At each visit **you will be asked to fill in a few short health and NHS-related questionnaires.**

If you take part in this trial, you will be asked to **donate urine samples** (approximately one table spoon) **at visit 1, visit 2, visit 4 and visit 5.**

The urine samples you give will be prepared for analysis and temporarily stored by research staff at your hospital before they are transferred to the University Hospitals of Leicester (Department of Chemical Pathology and Metabolic Diseases) for analysis. The urine samples will be used to analyse urine biomarkers (kidney measures of high blood pressure and its treatment). The samples will be identified by an anonymous number so that the researchers using the samples will not be able to identify you as the donor. Researchers may however have access to anonymised data collected about you and your treatment during the course of the study.

With your permission, we would like to treat the urine samples that you give as a gift.

After the trial has finished, with your consent, the research team would like to keep some of unused urine samples and the anonymised data collected about you for a potential use in future projects related to high blood pressure. The urine samples will be stored at the Department of Chemical Pathology and Metabolic Diseases, University Hospitals Leicester. This research may be carried out by the same team co-ordinating this study or the samples may be transferred to collaborators in other UK academic or commercial research settings. If samples you donated are transferred elsewhere this will be done anonymously, with nothing to identify you as the donor.

It is likely that some research with the samples you donate may be in collaboration with drug companies in the search for new treatments, which could lead to commercial gain for the company. When you consent to let us use your urine sample for research, we would like to make it clear that you would not be entitled to any financial gain.

No genetic test will be done as part of the study.



With your permission, your GP and other doctors who may be treating you will be notified that you are taking part in this trial but no data collected as a part of the study will be revealed to them.

Data Protection and Confidentiality

What information will you collect about me?

In order to participate in this research project we will need to collect information that could identify you, called "personal identifiable information". Specifically we will need to collect:

- Name
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- Postcode
- Medical History

Under what legal basis are you collecting this information?

We are collecting and storing this personal identifiable information in accordance with data protection law which protect your rights. These state that we must have a legal basis (specific reason) for collecting your data. For this study, the specific reason is that it is "a public interest task" and "a process necessary for research purposes".

What are my rights in relation to the information you will collect about me?

You have a number of rights under data protection law regarding your personal information. For example you can request a copy of the information we hold about you.

Will my participation in the study be confidential and my personal identifiable information be protected?

In accordance with data protection law, The University of Manchester is the Data Controller for this project. This means that we are responsible for making sure your personal information is kept secure, confidential and used only in the way you have been told it will be used. All researchers are trained with this in mind, and your data will be looked after in the following way:

The **study team** at this hospital will have access to your personal identifiable information, that is data which could identify you, but they will de-identify it **at visit 1 by using a study number instead**



of your name. However your **consent form, contact details, etc** will be retained for **15 years at site**. Documents will be securely stored and access restricted to authorised personnel.

Your data will be collected on paper format known as source documents. These will remain at the hospital site. This data will be entered by the research nurse at site onto an internet based database which is managed by a database team at University College London. The study team at the University of Manchester as the data controllers for this project along with the data management team at University College London will be able to access the information stored on this database. The database does not contain your name but will include your unique study number code, initials, date of birth and postcode. Information will be archived for 15 years following study completion.

Your participation in the study will be kept confidential to the study team and those with access to your personal information as listed above.

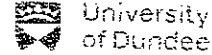
Will I be compensated for taking part?

You will not receive any payment for taking part in this trial, however we will offer a payment or voucher to compensate for parking costs and refreshments (up to £7 in value) for you to use at the hospital when attending the visits related to the study.

What is the duration of the research?

If you agree to take part in the study, you will have to:

- attend 1 to 5 visits at the hospital (between 30min to 1 hour each time)
- monitor your blood pressure at home for a week with the 7-day home-based blood pressure monitor provided by the nurses at visit 1, 2, 4 and 5
- return the blood pressure monitor and the home blood pressure diary to the hospital (a collection point will be arranged locally)
- provide a small urine sample on visit 1, 2, 4 and 5 (visits spanning a 6 month period)

The trial has also been peer reviewed by independent experts.

The I-PSS is based on the answers to seven questions concerning urinary symptoms. Each question is assigned points from 0 to 5 indicating increasing severity of the particular symptom. The total score can therefore range from 0 to 35 (asymptomatic to very symptomatic).

Although there are presently no standard recommendations into grading patients with mild, moderate or severe symptoms, patients can be tentatively classified as follows: 0 - 7 = mildly symptomatic; 8 - 19 = moderately symptomatic; 20 - 35 = severely symptomatic.

The International Consensus Committee (ICC) recommends the use of only a single question to assess the patient's quality of life. The answers to this question range from "delighted" to "terrible" or 0 to 6. Although this single question may or may not capture the global impact of BPH symptoms on quality of life, it may serve as a valuable starting point for doctor-patient conversation.
