Paul at present is doing work experience with Hepworth Carpets, Bathagte and appears to be enjoying this. Paul is keen to continue to do this line of work, and has been informed by [REDACTED] owner, that if he continues to work hard he may possible be offered part time paid work in January 2004. [REDACTED] has also stated that if a full time vacancy were to be come available he would consider offering Paul a full time job

CARE

Paul to remain in the Coach House Unit until January 2004, when his placement will come to a natural end. Thereafter, Paul is to move to one of Moore House Schools through care Projects in Livingston.

Paul still has some minor issues to deal with and staff will continue to work with Paul to address these.

HOME

Paul's home leave is more settled and both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] appear to be happy with Paul's behaviour and attitude when he is there. Occasionally Paul still has minor issues involving his attitude and not adhering to family structures and boundaries, but these tend to be resolved within the family.

Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are happy with Paul's decision to remain in West Lothian and continue to reside within one of Moore house Schools Projects.

HEALTH

Paul has a burn on his shoulder, due to being burnt with hot water when he was a small child. [REDACTED] informed writer that Paul is due to attend hospital in Dumfries to discuss the options available to him with a specialist. Paul to discuss this subject further with writer at a later date.

OTHERS

As from the above date Paul's case was transferred to [REDACTED] S/W, Dumfries Through care team. [REDACTED] will visit Paul every 2-3 weeks to discuss his future needs and requirements.

FUTURE PLAN

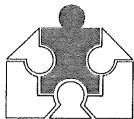
