January

Paul has had no problems with his Asthma this month, however needs regular check ups which he has always cancelled

Each capsule contains 250 mg amoxicillin (as trihydrate) as the active ingredient.
Also includes sunset yellow (E110) and carmoisine (E122).

For oral administration as directed by a physician.

Complete the course of treatment.

Do not exceed the stated dose.

Store in a dry place below 25°C.
