Paul not requiring staff in wakening him up in the mornings,

LONG TERM GOALS

Paul dealing with his anger and frustration himself, and budgeting his money.

Paul has been spoken to on a number of occasions about his attitude in Alberta, at the beginning of the Month Paul was spoken to about his purpose of begin in his placement and the need for more cooperation and his attitude. 08/03/05 Paul got very aggressive towards a staff member when he was asked about the age of a young friend he brought into the house, Paul swore and was verbally aggressive and was also under the influence of alcohol. 09/03/05 Paul was spoken to by Project Manager [REDACTED] about his unacceptable abusive behavior, Paul said that he was sorry. Paul attended a meeting with project leader [REDACTED] and key worker, this was the first time Paul attended a meeting and he was very co operative about his requirements in his placement and the aims/goals he wants to accomplish. Paul then took offence when a staff member that told him that he was on the phone to long he got aggressive and was shouting and swearing at the staff member. Paul's attitude has changed since peer [REDACTED] has left, Paul has been a lot more settled and is co operating more however the down side has been that Paul is top dog in Alberta and he has been making himself heard in front of staff and peer [REDACTED]. 28/03/05 Paul played his part in sneaking peer [REDACTED] into Alberta. Paul was very worried that he would lose his placement like peer [REDACTED] and continually asked staff member not to tell what he has done. Paul was very calm about getting caught but needed assurance that he wasn't going to lose his placement. It was explain to Paul that he needs to learn from his mistakes. Paul later that night came back in smelling of alcohol but was non-aggressive but told the staff member he really wants to stay in Alberta.

This has been the biggest change with Paul since being in Alberta, his attitude from the beginning of the Month to the end has seen Paul going from begin very aggressive, non cooperative, not knowing what he was going to do, wanting to leave Alberta and being under the influence of peer [REDACTED]. Paul has now attended a meeting with staff and has also got himself a job, taken more responsibility of his actions and is communicating and cooperating with staff.

SHORT TERM GOALS

To continue working with Paul to building relationships and work on managing his aggressiveness.

Paul's attitude at the beginning of the Month did improve, however he did have spells of aggressive behaviour and one particular evening Paul was showing off and acting the hard man, Paul tried to stick the head into a member of staff, this back fired on Paul with him coming off second best and his nose started to bleed. Since this Paul attitude has been a lot better. Paul has had moments of getting frustrated and angry but has not shown the level of aggression staff has seen.

Staff have been aware of Paul drinking more this Month, he has admitted this to staff, however any time Paul has done something wrong he always apologized to staff.

SHORT TERM GOALS

To continue working with Paul to building relationships and work on managing his aggressiveness.

Monitor and support Paul with any alcohol issues.

paul was drinking alcohol with peer [REDACTED] in his room both of them were asked to remove it from the house and reminded that under no circumstances that there was to be any alcohol on the premises.

21/06/05

once again paul was drinking alcohol with peer [REDACTED] in his room paul also sneaked steph up the stairs to his room at 10:40pm and left to take [REDACTED] back to granby at 2:20am, paul confessed all this to key worker the next day.

Key worker once again reminded paul of the house rules and also asked paul if he used protection paul answered this by saying no that he didn't need to as [REDACTED] has had the contraception injection key worker told paul that's not the point you should always protect yourself against STD, [REDACTED] has now been band from coming into the house.

Paul has been remained about the strong language he uses within the house and outside and that its not acceptable.

SHORT TERM GOALS

To continue working with Paul to co-operate with staff and other residents and work with Paul on supporting and managing his aggressiveness.

Monitor and support Paul with any alcohol issues and continue educating him on unprotected sex.

Paul had to be reminded again about having friend's in the house after visiting hour is over, Paul had sneaked [REDACTED] into the house at 12:15am but left shortly after when key worker had caught him.

This month Paul's maturity has de-creased as his behavior towards staff and relief staff and also other residents hasn't been very good Paul is very cheeky when he doesn't get his own way he also hasn't any time for peer [REDACTED] and tends to get on at him quite a lot, staff are monitoring this situation, Paul tends to get on well with new peer [REDACTED] and leaves peer [REDACTED] out. Paul also needs to improve on his anger and stop damaging house property i.e. damage to the house phone when he called his gran and she was crying because Paul's sisters wouldn't co-operate with her.

Paul has been reminded on a few occasions about his bad temper, staff are working on this.

Short Term Goals

For Paul to co-operate more with staff and to have his anger under control
